About Pullman Elementary School

Pullman Elementary School (PES) serves students in Preschool through Fifth Grade and is part of SoWashCo Schools. PES is committed to building self-esteem, enhancing creativity and individuality and building a community of lifelong learners. PES provides a nurturing environment where every student has the opportunity to become productive, knowledgeable and responsible citizen.

Student schedules are on a five-day rotation in which all students in 1st through 5th grades attend four classes of physical education, two blocks of music, two blocks of media and one hour of art. Students have additional extracurricular opportunities, as well as academic programs and enrichment such as targeted services, LEGO Club and Girls on the Run.
