Data Processing Services

The Superintendent/designee is authorized to enter into a contract with the Washington Schools Information Processing Cooperative (WSIPC) data processing cooperative through the educational service district, or other qualified vendor, to purchase the necessary data processing services. Terms of the agreement must be satisfactory to the district and such participation should continue to result in savings to the district in comparison to other means lawfully available to the district.

Acceptable Use of Information Services

The District maintains computers and information systems for instructional and administrative purposes. The district also maintains connections with other information systems. Staff, students and patrons are expected to conform to acceptable use policies and procedures as specified in the NTPS policy and procedures, *Student Rights and Responsibilities Handbook*, and the *Technology Support Services Technology Policy, Procedures and Standards Manual*. The use of information systems in the North Thurston Public Schools is a privilege which may be revoked by the district Superintendent or designee, WSIPC or other administrators of the K20 Network, at any time, for violation of conditions of use.
