REPAIR OF PRIVATE EQUIPMENT

The District believes that courses in repair of equipment such as vehicles, motors and appliances is an important part of the educational program of the District and that shop experience in District facilities is a desirable component of such courses.

The District further believes that the sole objective of such shop experience is the education and training of students. To the extent that this objective is achieved through the repair of property not owned by the District, such repair in District facilities is authorized in accordance with procedures established by the administration.

Property not owned by the District may be repaired as a part of District educational programs provided the following guidelines are adhered to:

- 1. Repairs must be within the instructional scope of the course under which the work is to be performed.
- 2. The repair of private property is at the sole discretion of the District.
- 3. Any person offering property for repair does so with the understanding that work to be performed is for the education of students and not intended to be in competition with private enterprise.
- 4. Before accepting private property for repair, its owner agrees in writing that the District and its agent will not be liable for any damage to it caused by storage, use, vandalism or improper repair of the property.
