POLICY - GOALS 9000

The Board recognizes the importance that the physical plant plays in enhancing the instructional program. The District shall develop an aggressive program to maintain and/or upgrade the buildings and grounds of the District. Facilities represent a long-term investment of the District and the state. The functional utility of such facilities can be increased with a regular maintenance program monitored by staff.

The District further recognizes the importance of planning in order to provide the anticipated facility needs of the future. The District shall maintain a regular review of birth data, mobility characteristics, industrial development and housing development.
