

It is the desire and intent of the Board that the educational program of the District as defined in District policy and curricular guides be conducted in permanent facilities of safe, effective and appropriate design and condition.

When facilities are unsafe, ineffective and/or inappropriate, whether by reason of being aged and worn or by reason of being too small for the number of students to be served, it is the Board's policy to seek appropriate funding for correction of the deficiencies so as to permit continuation of the educational services. The Superintendent shall provide the Board with a recommendation regarding a dollar amount and a funding source for the Board to consideration along with a summary of facility.

When funding essential to correction of facilities deficiencies, is not approved by voters or otherwise is not available the Superintendent shall recommend methods to continue the desired educational services. Consideration will be given to: the utilization of temporary, relocatable classroom units; the rental of facilities; discontinuing programs, or alternative scheduling methods to increase facility efficiency; and other strategies to maximize use of existing facilities and/or programming to address facility deficiencies.
