Promoting access for students with disabilities to a public education that cultivates unique abilities and maximizes potential.

What is the SEAC?

Virginia school divisions are required to have a local Special Education Advisory Committee (SEAC). The purpose of the committee is to provide an opportunity for parents and community members to have a voice in the way that the school division provide services to students with disabilities. SEAC members include parents of individuals with disabilities, individuals with disabilities, a teacher representative, and members of the community.

Anyone interested in improving the education of individuals with disabilities in Fauquier County is welcome. The SEAC works collaboratively with the Office of Special Education to identify needs in the education of students with disabilities. The SEAC provides recommendations to the superintendent and the school board.

Functions of the SEAC:

- Advise the local school division of needs in the education of children with disabilities.
- Participate in the development of priorities and strategies for meeting the identified needs of children with disabilities.
- Submit periodic reports and recommendations regarding the education of children with disabilities to the division superintendent for transmission to the local school board.
- Assist the local school division in interpreting plans to the community for meeting the special needs of children with disabilities for educational services.
- Review the policies and procedures for the provision of special education and related services prior to submission to the local school board.
- Participate in the review of the local school division's annual plan.



Virginia State SEAC

In addition to local SEACs, the Virginia State SEAC meets quarterly to discuss issue related to the needs of children with disabilities in the state. The SSEAC develops priorities and recommendations for meeting those needs, and reports annually to the Virginia Board of Education. Members of the SEAC include representatives of stakeholder groups as prescribed by IDEA. A majority of members are individuals with a disability or parents of children eligible to receive services under IDEA. Members are appointed by the Board of Education.
