In-Person Tours

It's a chance to hear directly from the teachers about their curriculum, meet administrators, and talk with current St. Paul's parents about why they chose the school. This is an adults-only event though child care is available by registration.</p>

This open house is an opportunity to meet with our teachers in person, chat with administrators, and engage in short activities that are led by our teachers. This event is geared towards prospective middle schoolers so be sure to bring them!</p>

- **APPLICATION**

Complete and submit the Application for Admission. **Early Application** (\$75 application fee) deadline is **December 1, 2023**. **Regular Application** (\$95 application fee) deadline is **January 16, 2024**.

- **TEACHER RECOMMENDATION(S)**

Give/delegate the Recommendation Forms to your child's teachers. One recommendation is required for K-8 (and a second is optional). The recommendation(s) is due by **January 31, 2024**.

- **REPORT CARDS AND TRANSCRIPTS**

The Record Release Form must be signed and given to your **child's current school**. Their school will release your child's report cards and transcripts from the past two years ('21-'22, '22-'23) and fall of '23. These are due by **January 31, 2024**.

* First grade applicants: will have **kindergarten report card** (1st semester) only.

* Second grade applicants: will have **kindergarten and first semester** of first grade only.

* Third-Eighth grade applicants: will have past two years (**'21-'22, '22-'23**) and **fall of '23** report cards and transcripts.

- **SIGN-UP FOR AN ASSESSMENT**

Once you have submitted your child's application, you will need to sign-up for an assessment via Ravenna).

Admission Decision Timeline

- **NOTIFICATION OF ADMISSION DECISION – Thursday, March 14, 2024.**
- **ENROLLMENT CONTRACTS DUE – 10% registration deposit by Thursday, March 21, 2024.**
