- ❑ Students took NJSLA Mathematics Assessments in grades 3 – 8 and End of Course Assessments in Algebra I, Geometry, and Algebra II.

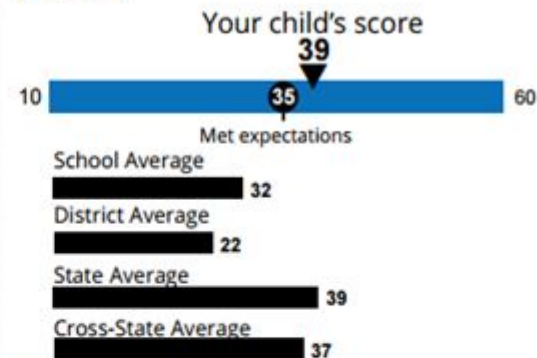

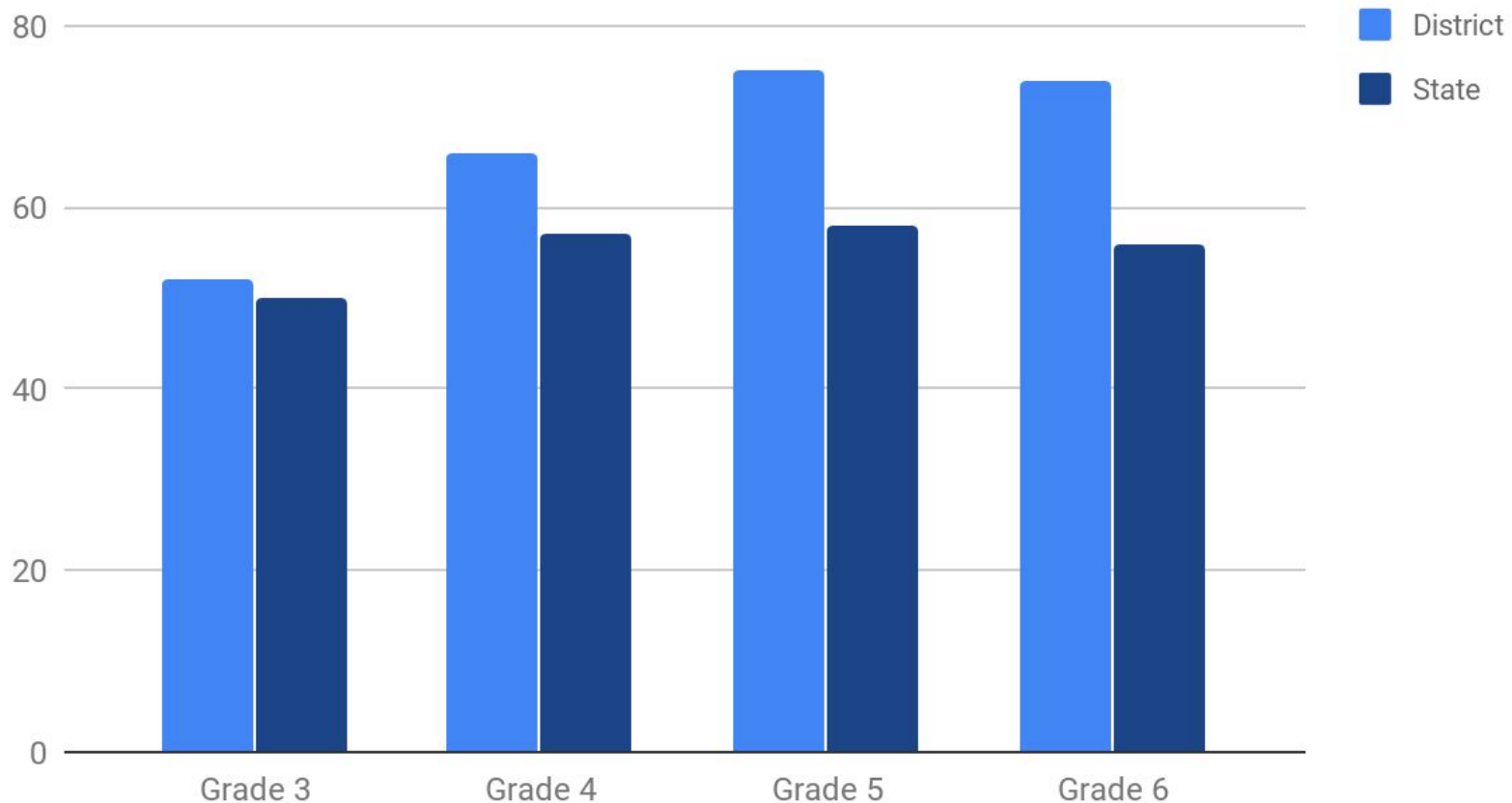

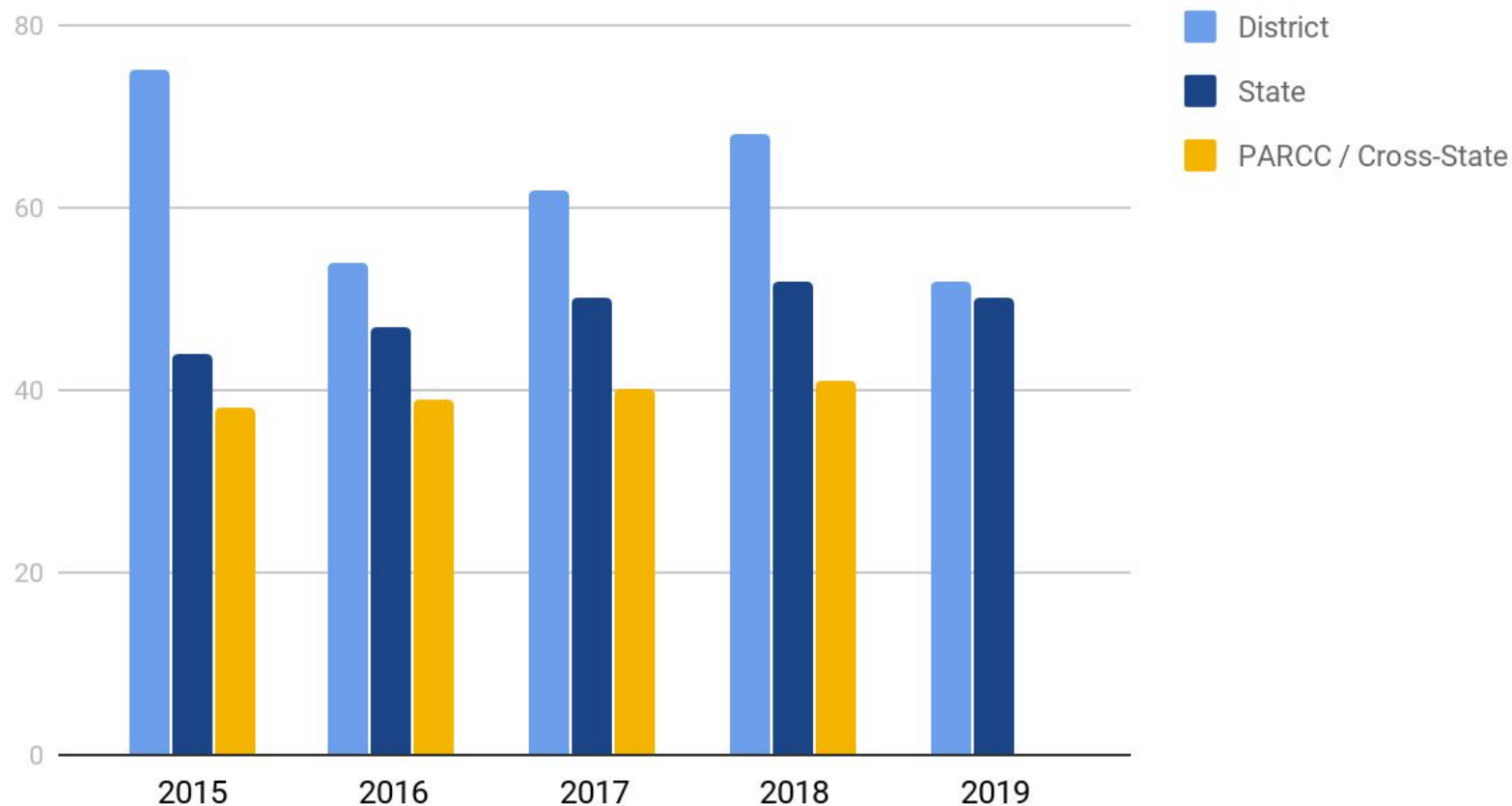
## Total Percentage - Levels 4 & 5

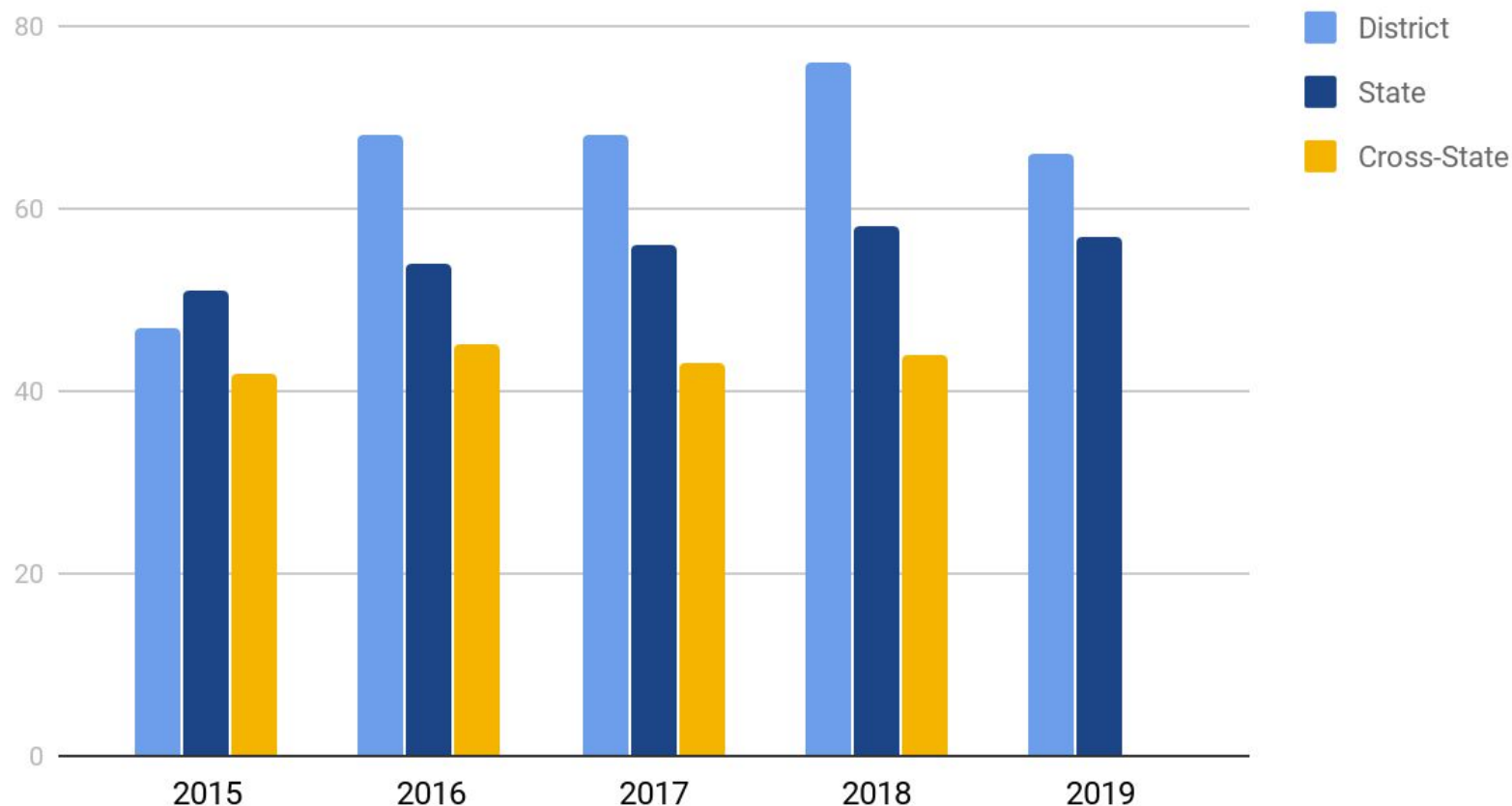
Percentages - Levels 4 & 5 Grade 3

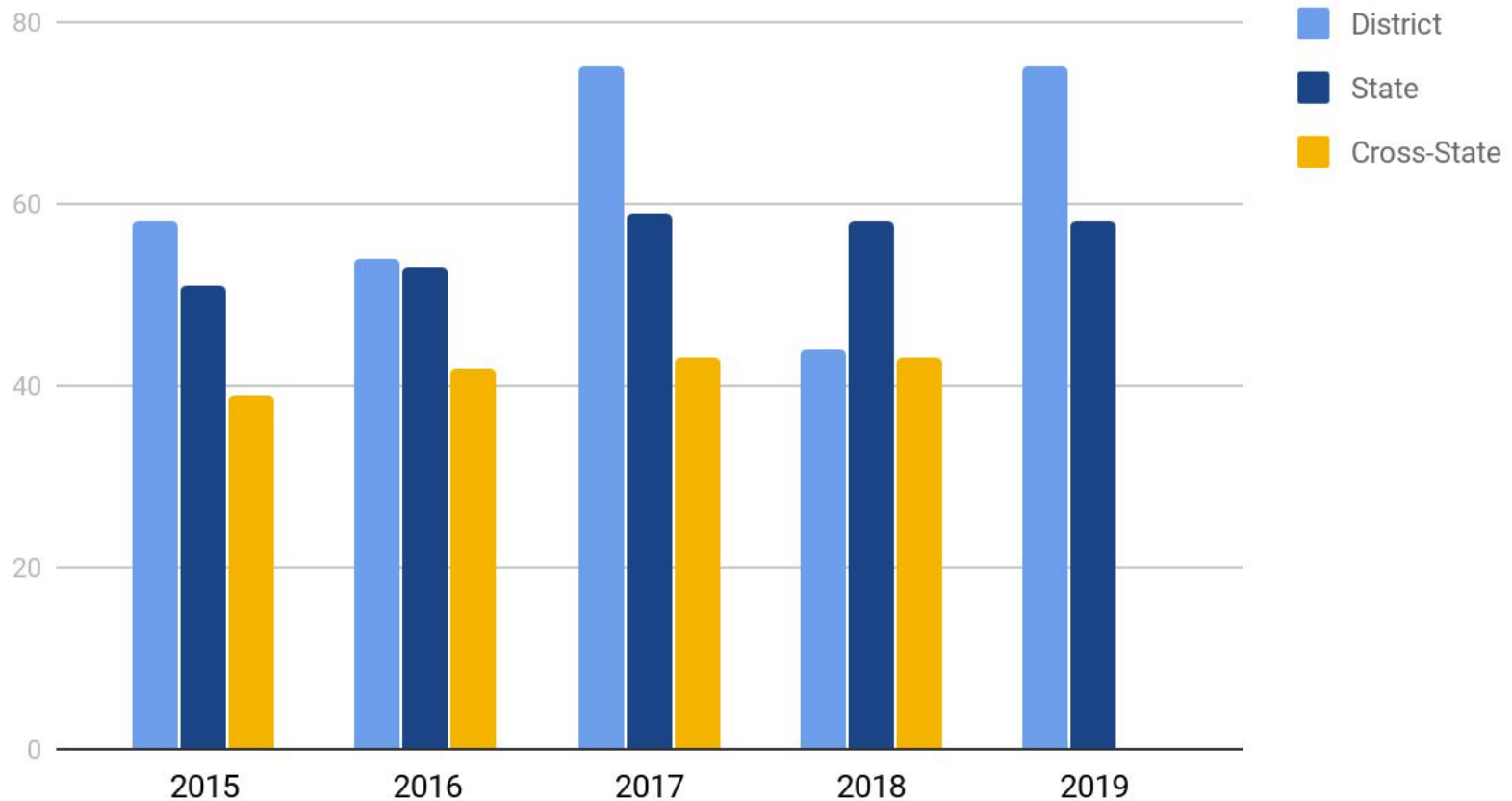
Percentage - Levels 4 & 5 Grade 4

Percentages - Levels 4 & 5 Grade 5

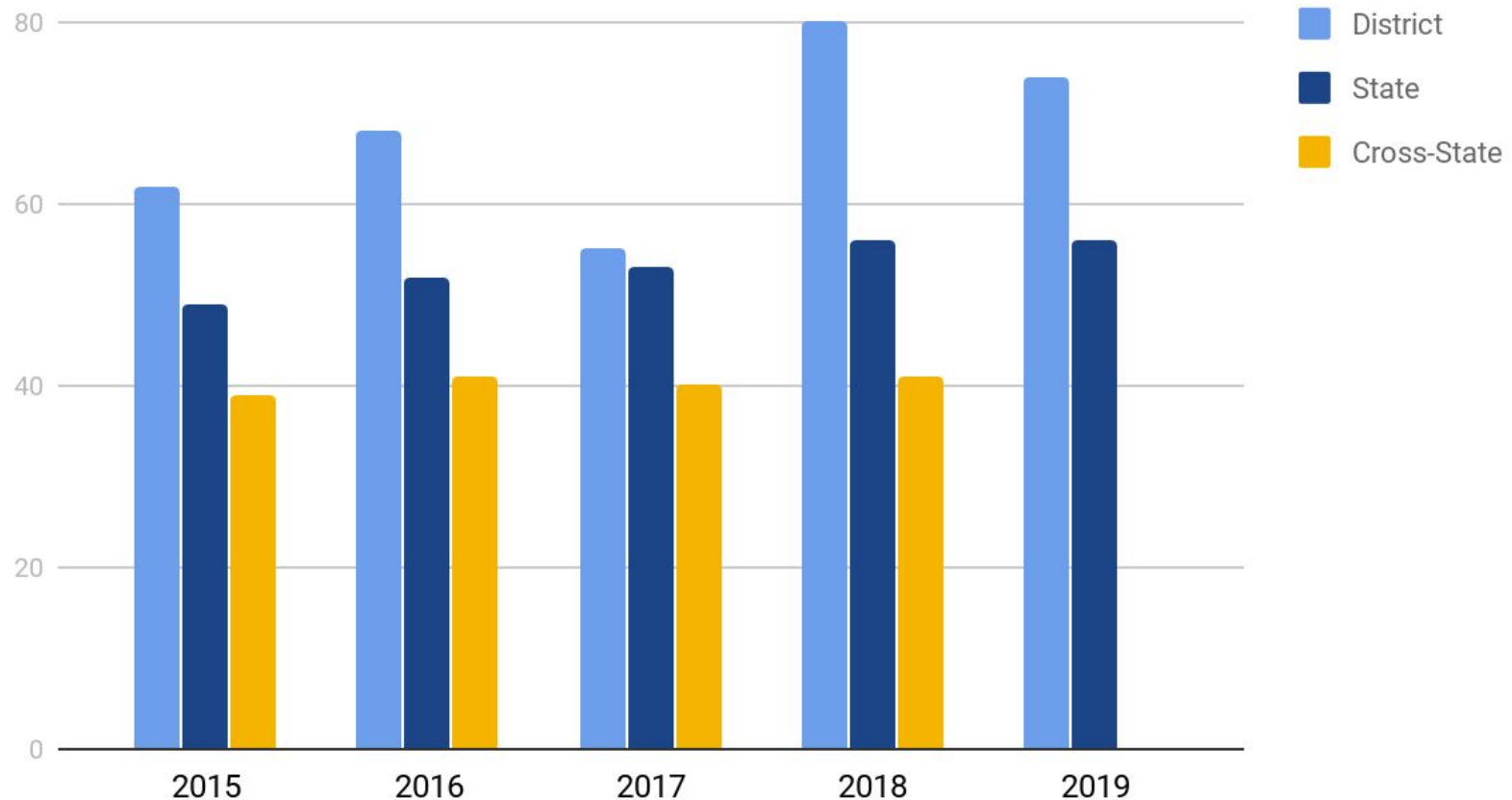

Percentages - Levels 4 & 5 Grade 6

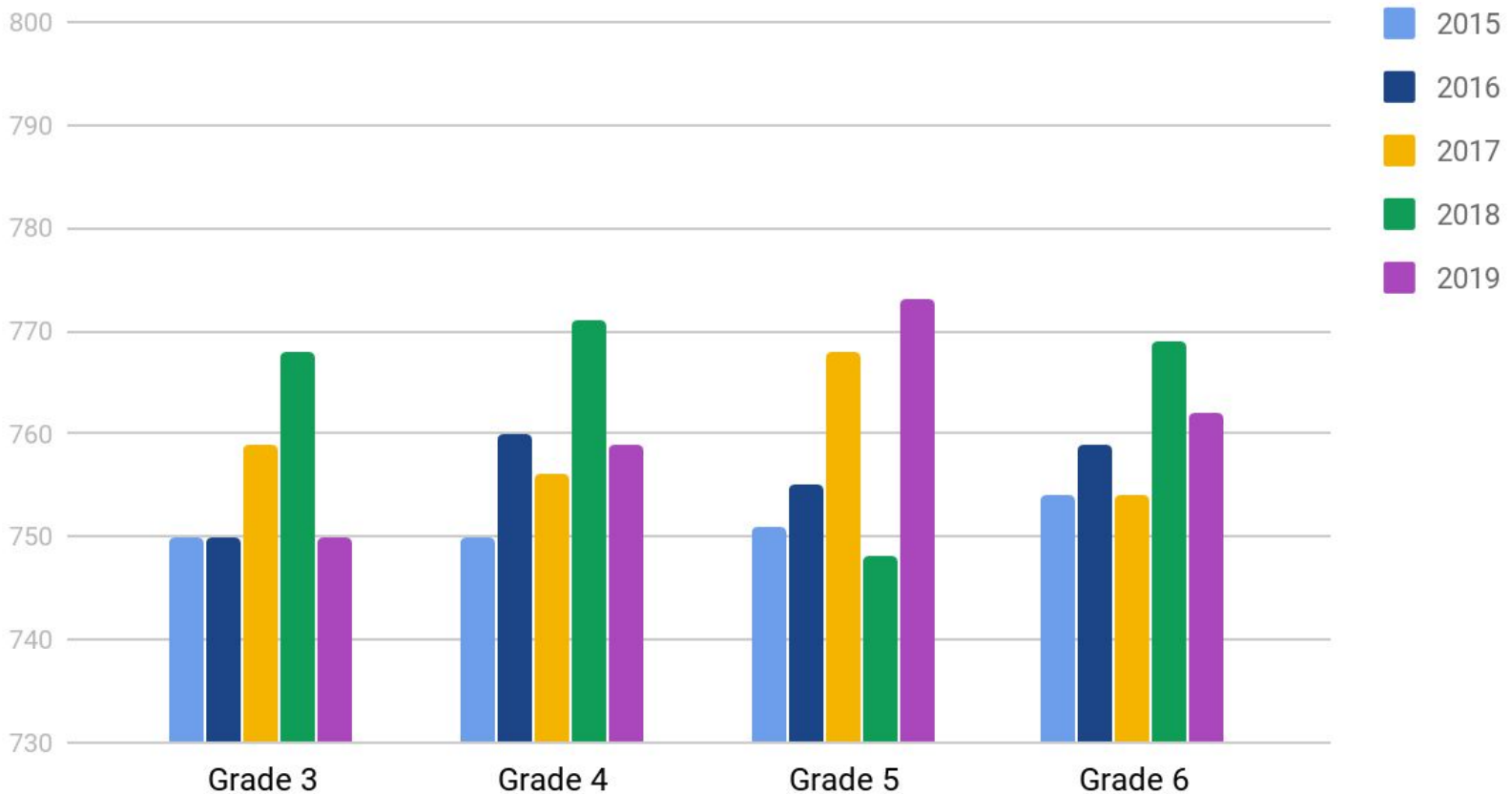

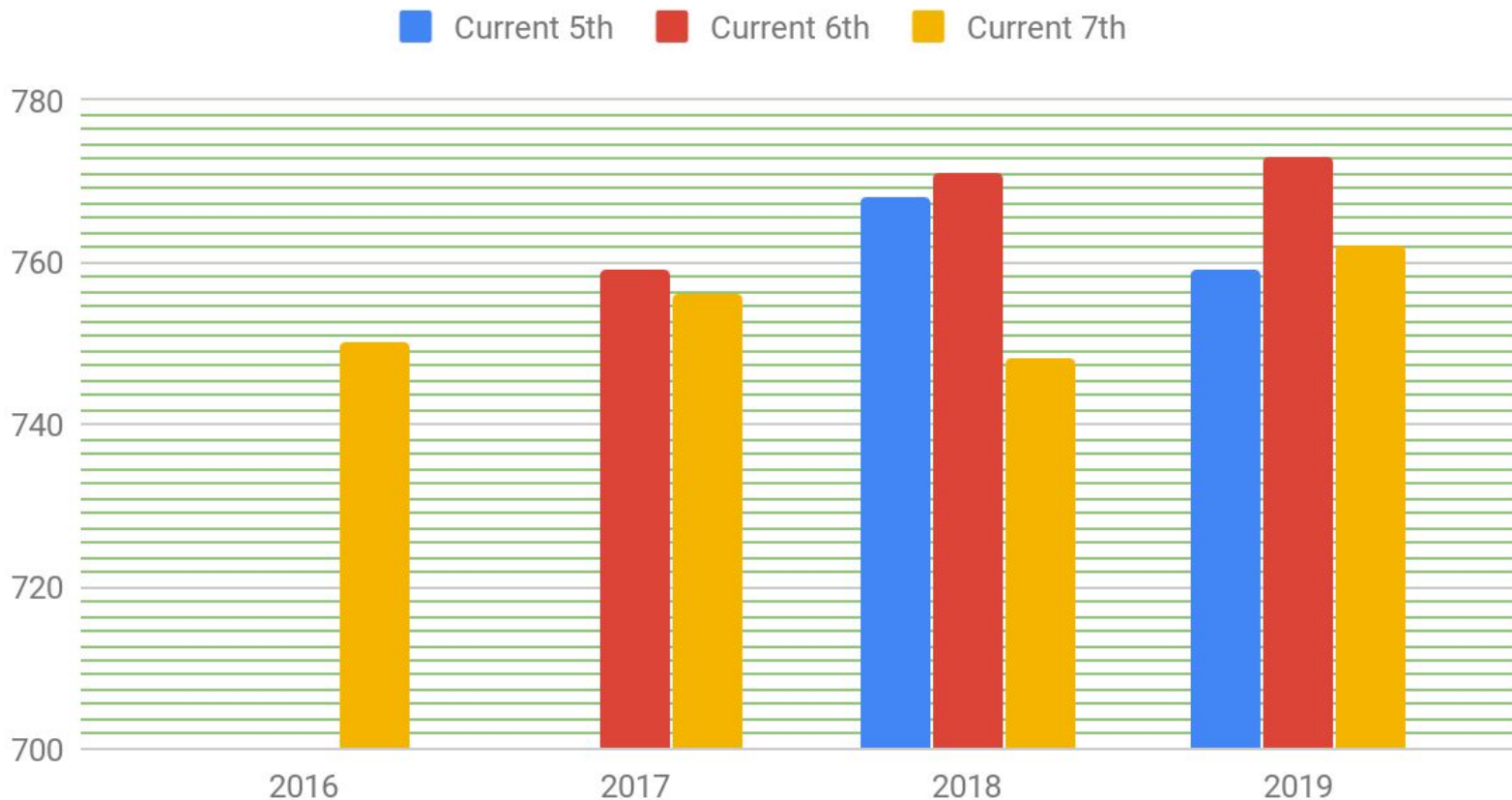
# 2015-2019 Language Arts/Literacy Overall Average by Grade

Current 5th, 6th and Current 7th

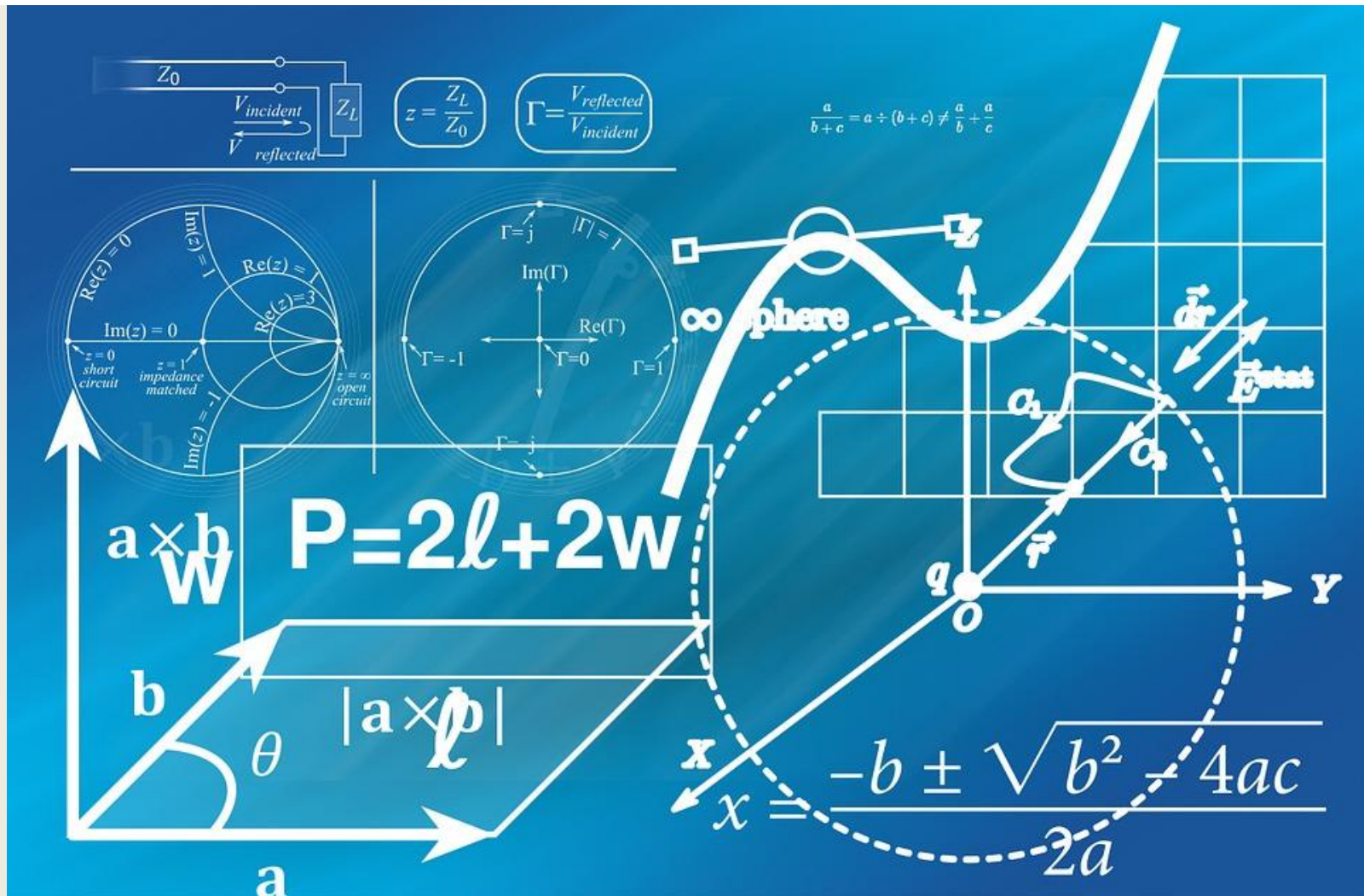

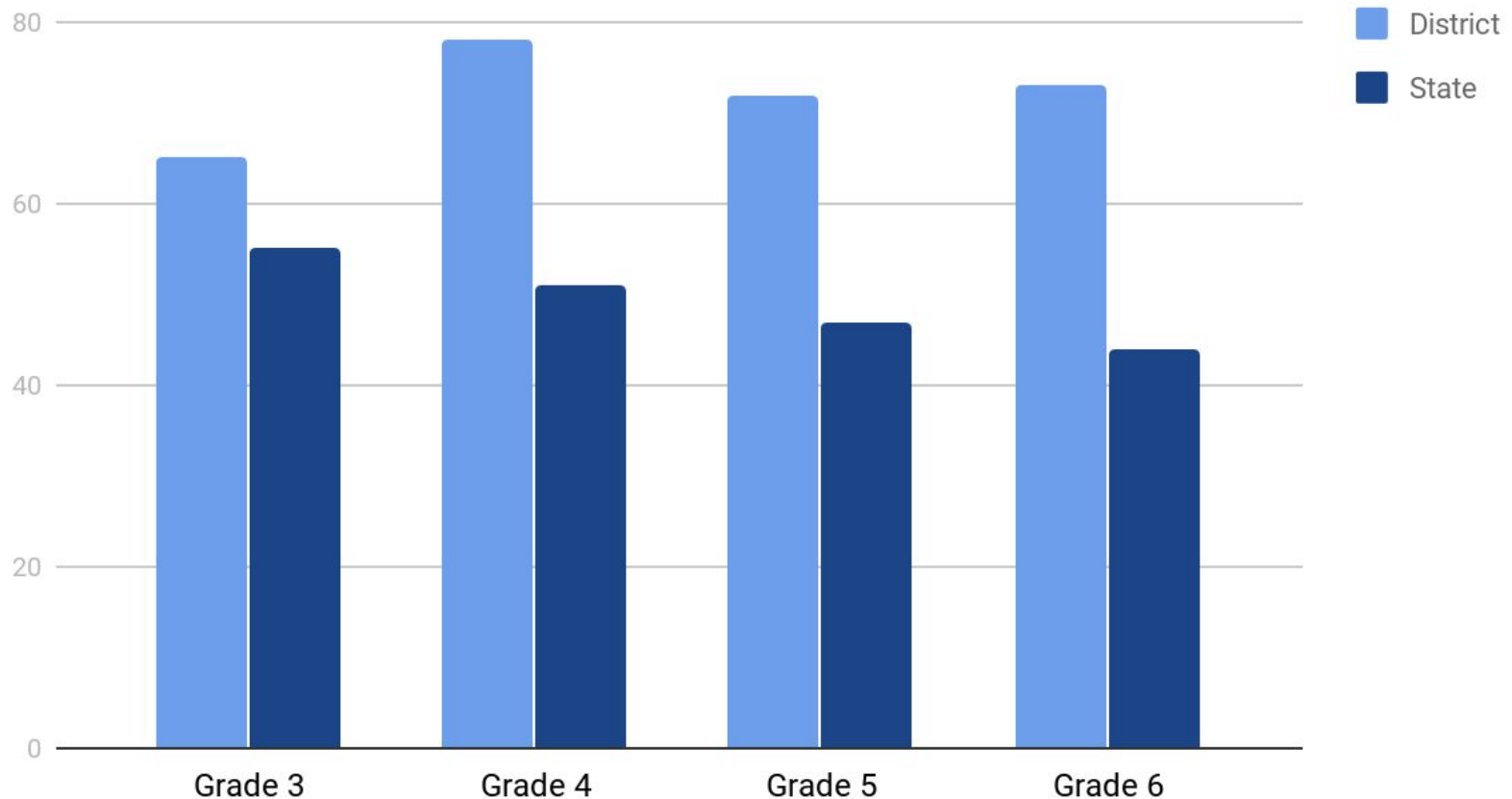

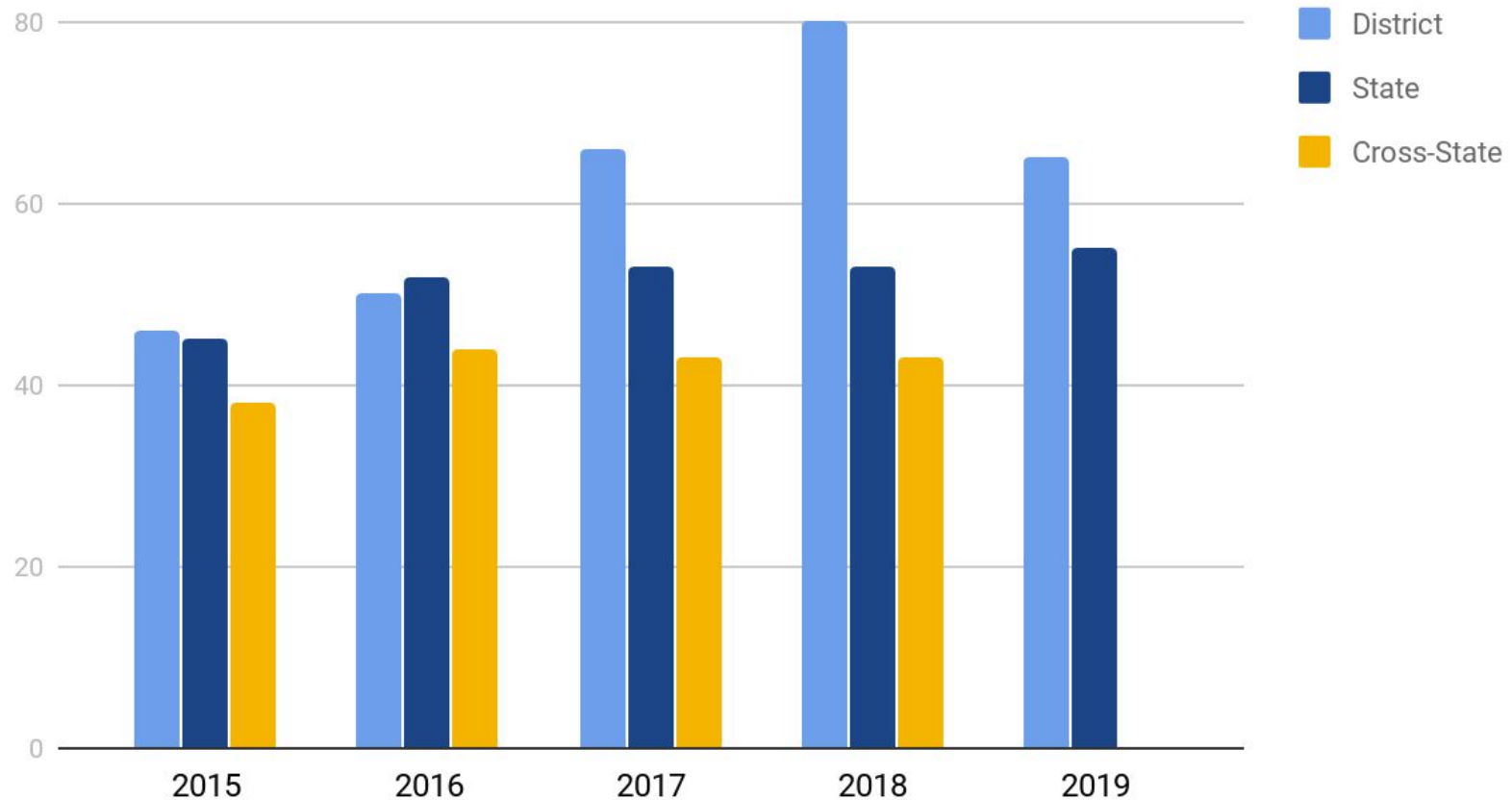
## Total Percentage - Levels 4 & 5

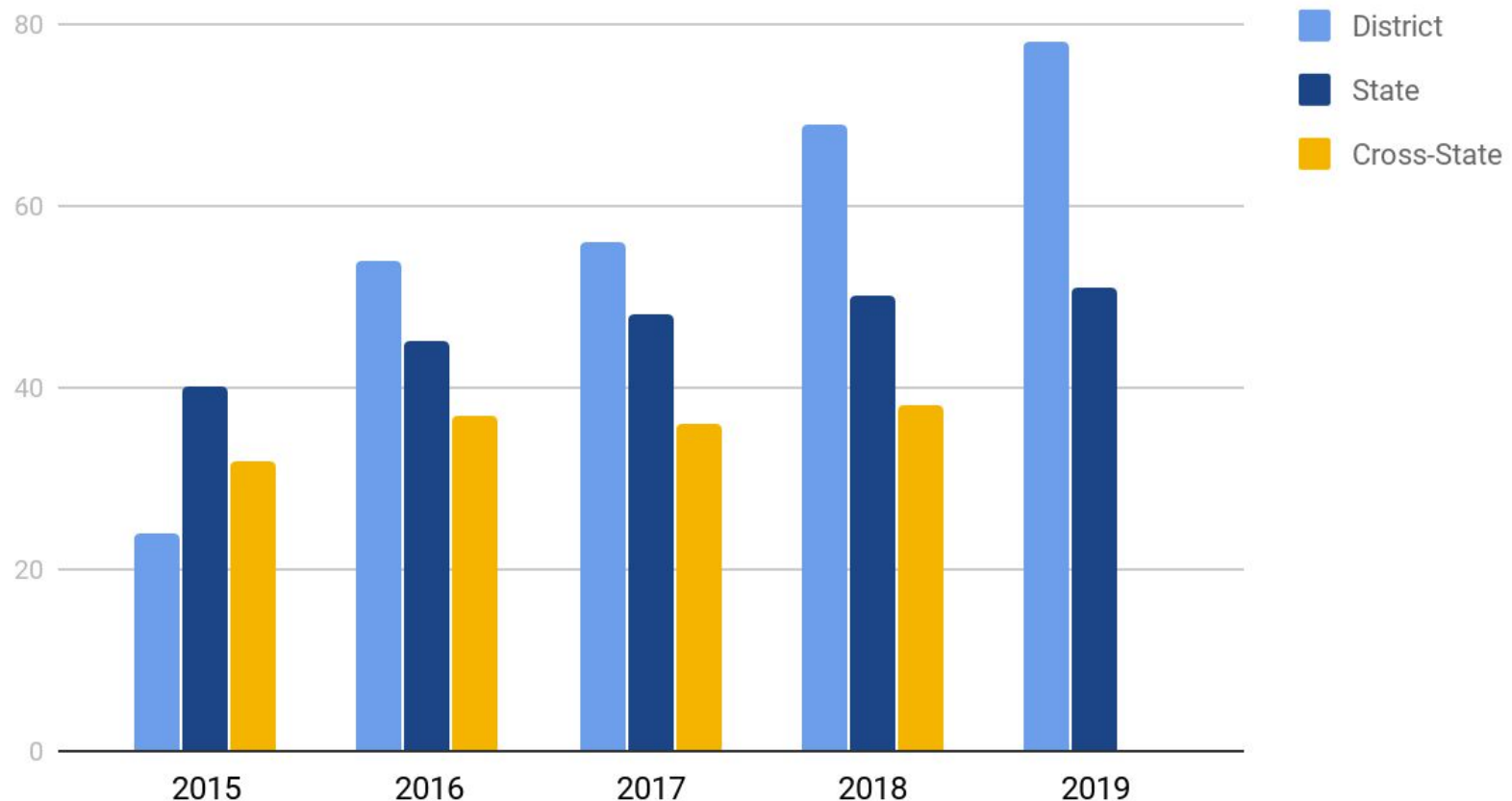
Percentages - Levels 4 & 5 Grade 3

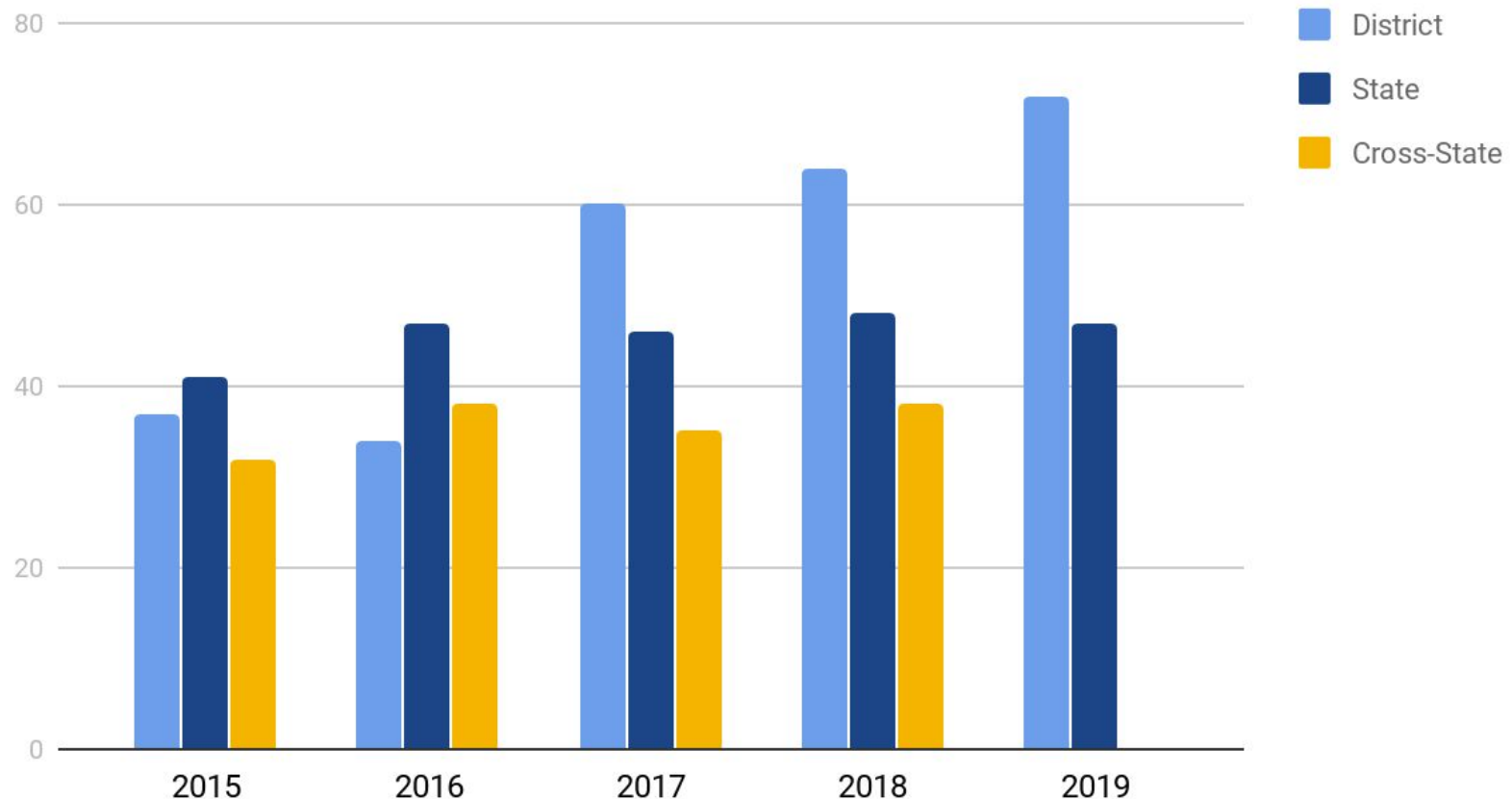
Percentages - Levels 4 & 5 Grade 4

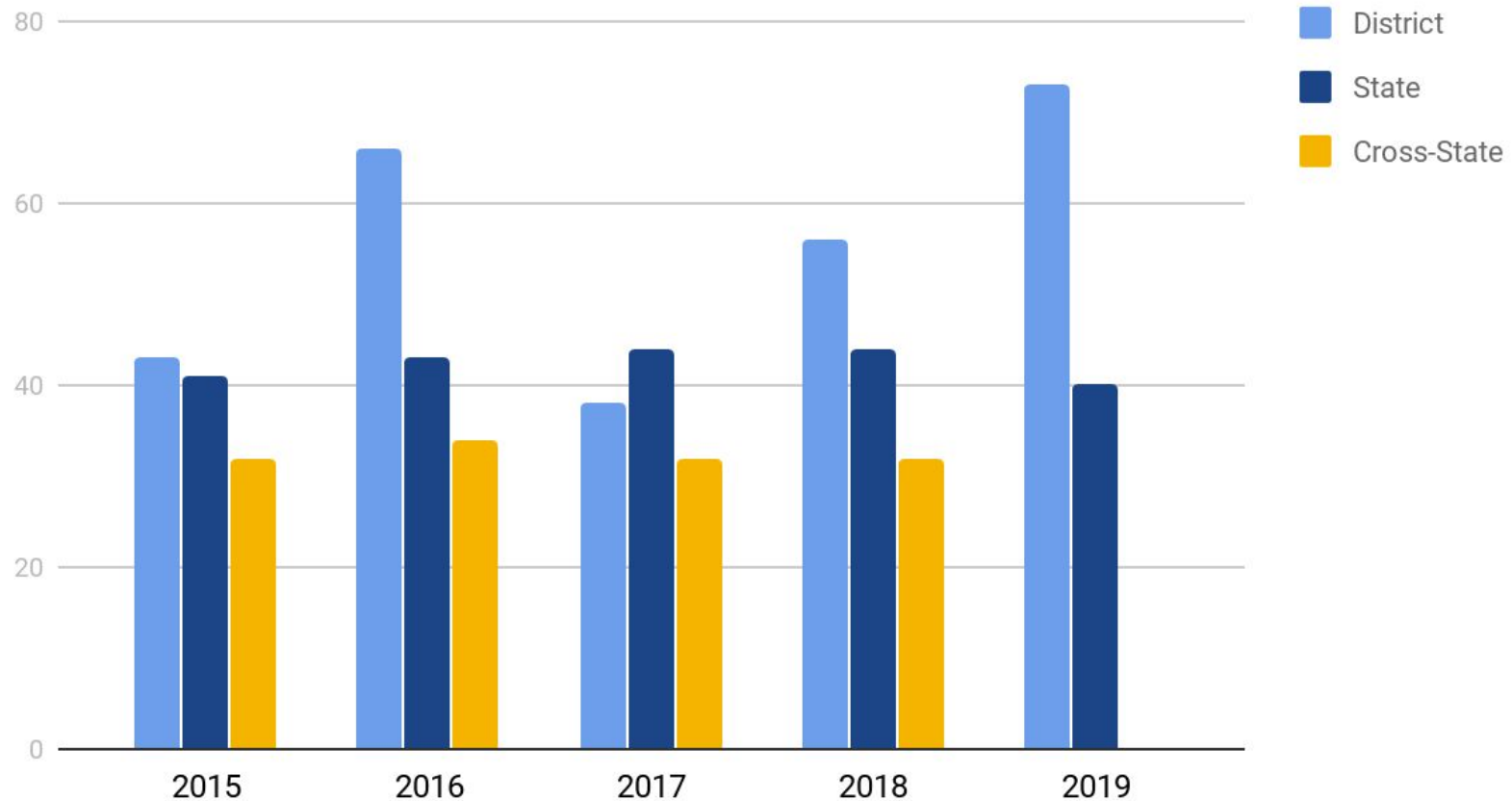
Percentages - Levels 4 & 5 Grade 5

Percentages - Levels 4 & 5 Grade 6



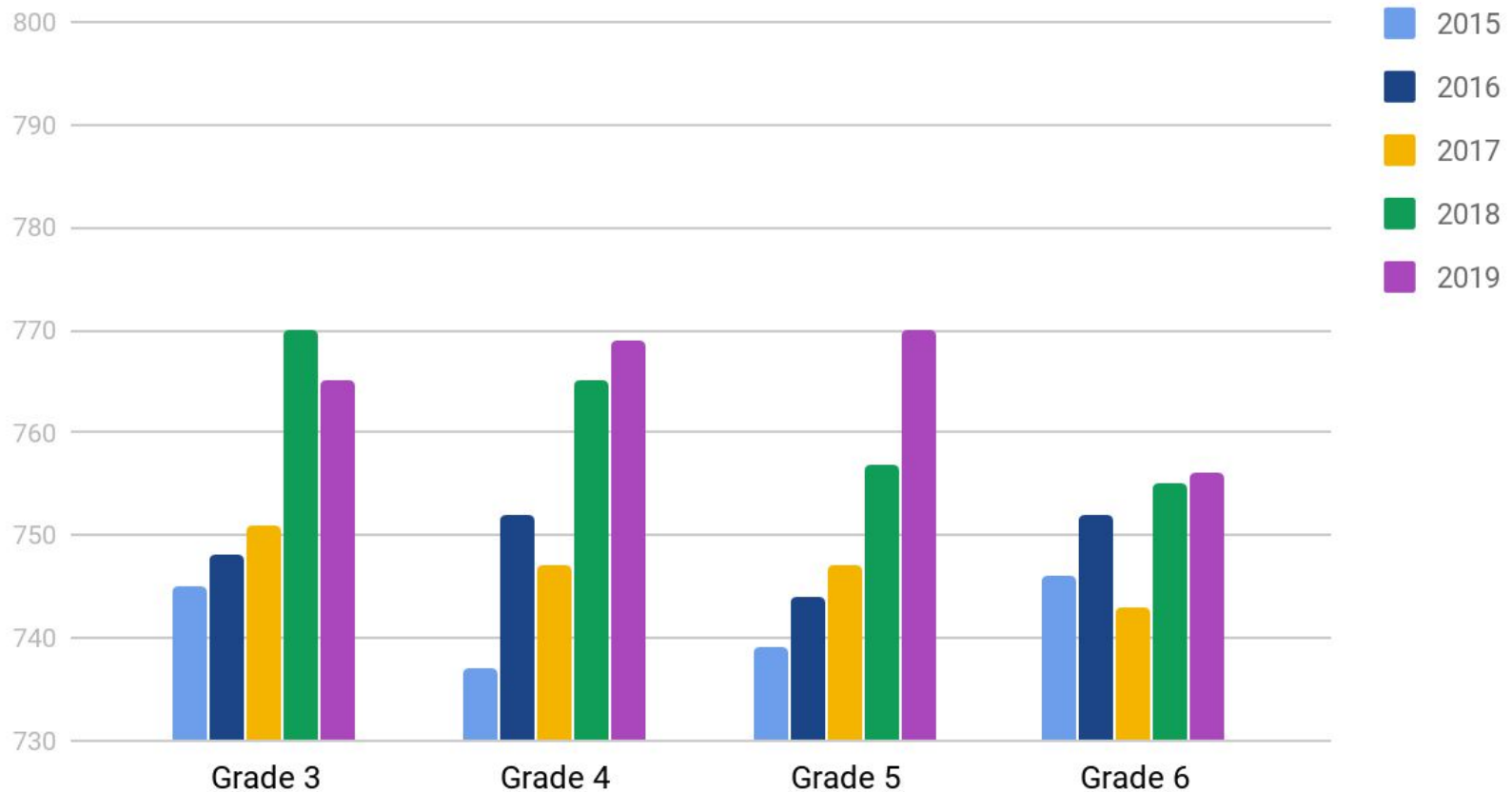

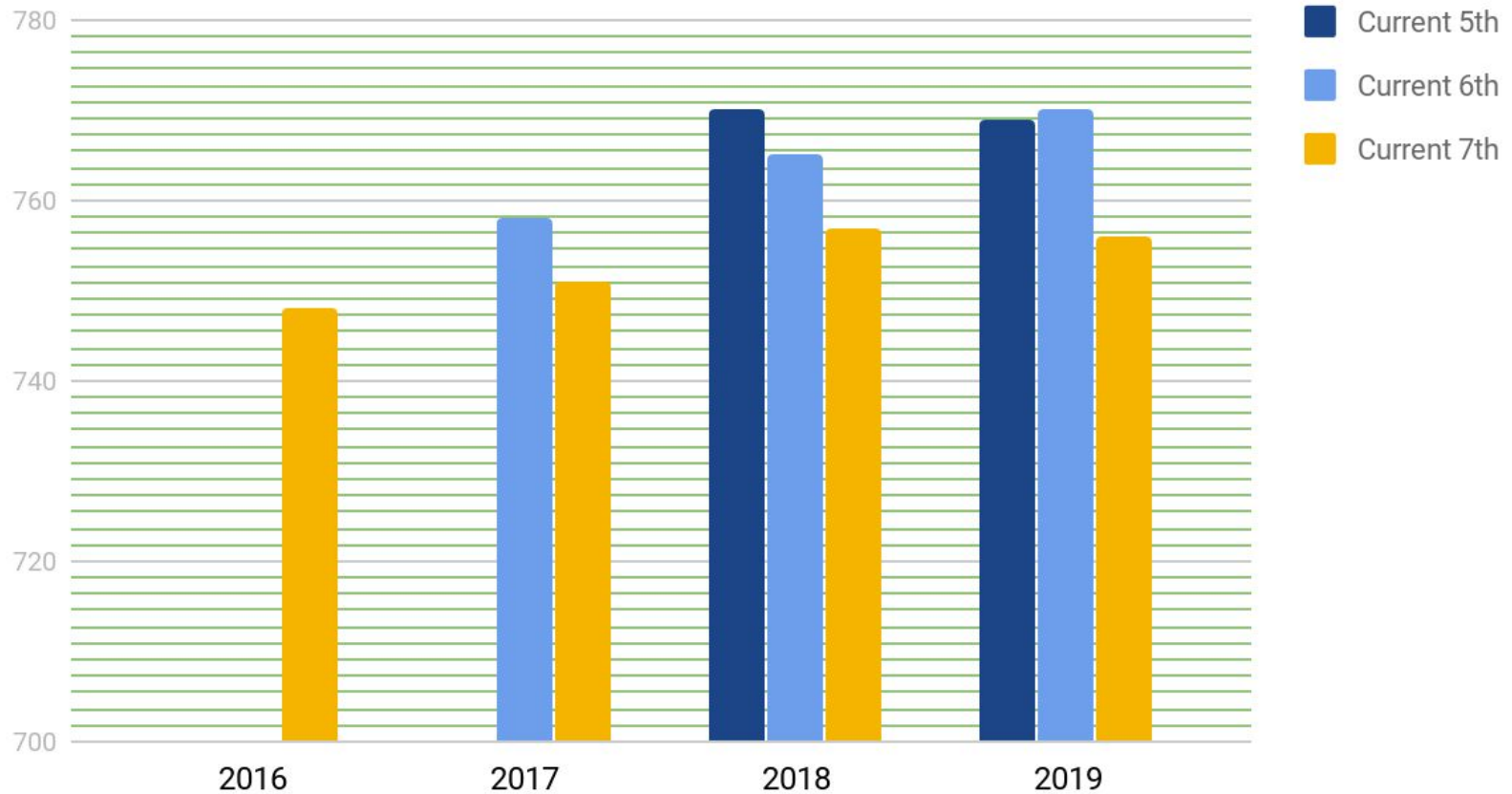
# 2015-2019 Mathematics Average

# NJSLA Interventions

How is the data used?

- PLC meetings focused on analysis, disaggregation, and comparison to local assessment & benchmark data
- Student Growth Objectives focused on identified areas of weakness at grade levels and/or at teacher-specific levels
- **NEW** *NJSLA Readiness Course* for Grades 5 & 6
- Primary grades presented with data overview as well as identified trends in order to provide support through instructional adjustments
- District curriculum reviewed and revised based upon identified patterns or trends revealed by data analysis
- BSIP entrance criteria considers NJSLA scores
- Student “level” information articulated and used to provide differentiated support within the classroom and recommend supplemental supports (e.g. Homework Club)
