Internet safety practices are in place to protect the students of Maypearl ISD.

Maypearl ISD will educate all students about appropriate online behavior, including interacting with other individuals on social networking websites and in chat rooms and cyber bullying awareness and response. Students are educated on the dangers of cyber bullying. Their use is monitored and filtered to discourage bullying.

Maypearl ISD uses Derby Tech CIPA compliant hardware to protect our users. The District Technology staff has access to allow and block web sites as needed.

The contracts for network access must be signed before given access to the District Network or Internet. Students and staff must have a signed agreement on file in the building principal's office before having access to the District Network system.
