All MISD students will receive their SMART tag ID by Monday, November 7, 2022.

SMART tag<sup>TM</sup> is designed to ensure authorized ridership and improve the safety and security of students who utilize school bus transportation. SMART tag<sup>TM</sup> provides live monitoring of where and when students load onto and unload off their school bus to keep transportation, administrators and parents informed. Instructions are also provided on the website to opt-in for notifications on your bus rider.

All students will be expected to wear their SMART tag for:

- security purposes,
- on the bus for location tracking,
- in the library to check out items,
- in the cafeteria to purchase breakfast & lunch items,
- free entry into extra-curricular events for grades 6-12.

Replacement SMART tags will cost \$5.

November 7- December 2, 2022 will be our "break-in" period to allow students and staff to acclimate to wearing their ID in school and on the bus. Students will be given reminders and warnings if not wearing their SMART tag ID.

After this timeframe, students not wearing their ID on the bus will receive consequences according to the information found in the Bus Rider Handbook (p.6) and Student Handbook (p.95-96). Campus consequences for students not wearing their ID will be communicated the week of November 28, 2022. Consequences will begin on December 5, 2022.
