Our Topic

This half term our topic is The Tudors and The Monarchy. The children will be learning about what life was like in the Tudor times.

They will be learning about how the Tudors were educated; they games that they played; food that they ate; sports that they played; their living and working conditions. The children will learn all about Henry VIII and the divide in the church during his ruling. They will also learn about treason. They will also learn about the changes in Monarchy over time.

The Tudors: Kings, Queens, Scribes and Ferrets! By Marcia Williams- "The historical tales are retold in Marcia Williams' distinctive comic book style, with speech bubbles and many humorous details in both the text and illustrations that pupils will love."

Shakespeare's Globe (I Was There) by Valerie Wilding- "This short novel follows the exciting story of a young boy actor who was part of Shakespeare's own theatre company. Written from the first-person perspective, the text helps children to imagine what it was like to live in Shakespeare's times and be part of his plays in their original productions."
