ATTENDANCE CHANGES

At Mountainside, we strive to ensure we are taking accurate attendance and to ensure students are attending school regularly according to Washington state law. One small change that we are beginning is requesting that you provide a doctor's note when your child is absent from school for an appointment. With a doctor's note, the attendance is coded as to not affect your student's attendance in relation to the Becca Bill process. Without a doctor's note, the absence will be counted toward the Becca Bill process. Getting into the habit of getting a note will be very helpful and this will mirror what is requested of you when your child reaches high school. Thank you!
