3 members of the Board (Goldsmith, Doerr, Reymann) attended the Township Committee meeting. During the Public Hearing for a \$500,000 Bond Ordinance Goldsmith presented talking points (previously circulated to Board) explaining why the Township should be cautious before approving creation of debt that will cause a 3 to 4 cent tax increase to be continued for the next ten years. The Committee listened attentively, thanked Goldsmith for his interest and then passed the Ordinance by a 3-0 vote.

**8/2/18 5:30 p.m.Meeting with Senator Van Drew, Cape May Courthouse, NJ 08210**

5 members of the Board (Zebedies, Ardito, Carrugno, Goldsmith and Reymann) attended a meeting with Sen Van Drew in his Cape May Court House Office. The Board presented the talking points previously prepared regarding the District's loss of State Aid. A discussion was held regarding the situation. Sen Van Drew is trying to arrange a meeting for later in the month with the Commissioner of Education. He is also talking to many other School Districts in Atlantic and Cape May Counties. They will all be invited to the meeting with the Commissioner. Van drew acknowledged that there is not a lot he can do, but he will help us to get relief. Meeting lasted approximately forty minutes.
