5.0 COVID Update

- Current number is at 94. This is in large part due to 25 students at Berry Miller JH and 11 at PHS. Prior to this week, we had been at about 35.
- 3rd party testing with Thermo Fisher
- We did a vaccine event last weekend 11th (Sat). 120 vaccines. 52 pediatric, 16 12 and up. 52 boosters. Kroger and Pearland.

- First pediatric clinic was Nov 20th and completed 110 vaccines that day 60 pediatric, 50 boosters
- Still doing rapid testing at every campus and rapid testing center for staff and students that are not well and have stayed home. Consent is on the district web page.
- Hours might change after the break, but more staff is being lined out by ThermoFisher.

6.0 Scheduled Trainings for the district

- We will be scheduling Stop the Bleed training for all students in grades 7-12. Likely around march. Last year this was modified due to the inability to meet in person.
- Will speak with the nurses on Jan 4th to receive their input on best timing.
- Jan 5th Reunification drill- team will perform a mock reunification to work out kinks that we may have. This will become an annual event for our district.
- Working with Nurse Beck to create monthly health and safety training for staff to include CPR, Stop the Bleed, Basic first aid etc.
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7.0 Social Media Threats

- There were several threats of different varieties that we worked through over the past few weeks.
- All came after the Oxford Michigan school shooting. Traditionally after every school shooting, there has been an increase in threats for 3 weeks following. Some of these are copy cat hoaxes, others are generic gun threats.
