

SUPPLEMENTAL MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

SUPPLEMENTAL MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS AND BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE CHAPPAQUA CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT, hereinafter referred to as “the District” and **THE CHAPPAQUA CONGRESS OF TEACHERS**, hereinafter referred to as “the CCT”;

HEREBY, the District and the CCT believe it to be in their mutual best to settle the grievance filed by the CCT dated 2/7/2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed as follows:

Teaching Assistants (TA’s) who perform the duties of New York State Regents proctors during the summer months shall receive hourly rate compensation based on the current teacher’s salary schedule BA+45 Step 1 divided by 200 divided by 6. Those TA’s who performed Regents proctoring duties during the summer of 2022 shall be retroactively compensated for the difference between this new rate and the rate they received.

This supplemental memorandum of agreement shall be non-precedent setting, and not to be introduced by either party in any future proceedings {negotiations, administrative or judicial} and shall sunset effective close of business, June 30, 2025.

The above mentioned grievance is hereby withdrawn with prejudice against being refiled under the parties’ grievance procedure, in arbitration, or any other forum.

SO AGREED this 24 day of MARCH, 2023, subject to ratification by the Board of Education.
