Lenape Technical School will adhere to a mask optional policy for the 2023-2024 school year for all students and staff. Any student or staff member may utilize a mask for their own individual health need. Students and staff that feel ill are encouraged remain home and seek medical attention.

The school nurse will notify parents when their student presents themselves as being ill while in school. It will be the responsibility of the family to pick-up the student from school when ill during the day.

Lenape Technical School will continue to offer services that focus not only on the educational needs of the students but the social, emotional, mental health and other needs that may arise. Coordination of services with sending districts and ARIN IU28 combined with professional development for all staff on best practices will be used to identify areas of needs and remediation strategies for students. Lenape Technical School's School Based Therapy Program is coordinated that students can receive mental health services no matter the learning module used for the school or specific student. Staff members will have access to our provided EAP services for assistance.

c. <u>Handwashing and respiratory etiquette</u> ;	Lenape Technical school is always a strong proponent of handwashing. This includes signage and hand sanitizer in all classroom spaces. promotes that student's remain at home with respiratory infections and provides for appropriate make-up work, to maintain a student's education. The same is true for staff members.
d. <u>Cleaning</u> and maintaining healthy facilities, including improving <u>ventilation</u> ;	Lenape Tech is continuing to update all HVAC units with updated filters and fresh air intakes. Continued sanitation methods will continue throughout the day, along with evening custodial services.
e. Daily Self-Health Checklist.	Lenape Tech encourages students and staff members to engage in daily self-checks prior to coming to school. For any illness anyone with symptoms including temperatures of 100.00 degrees or more should remain home.
f. Appropriate accommodations for students with disabilities with respect to health and safety policies.	Lenape Tech follows the recommended health and safety plan within a students IEP or 504 Plan in addition to any directive from a student's medical care professional.
g. Coordination with state and local health officials.	Lenape Technical School will continue to coordinate with the Department of Health and our school physician for guidance.
