QUALIFICATIONS

Be a senior at a high school in Lake, Porter, or LaPorte county, and be on track to graduate in Spring/Summer of 2024

Have a minimum 3.0 cumulative Grade Point Average

Attend an accredited college, university, or trade school in the Fall of 2024

Pursue an associate's or bachelor's degree, or a minimum 2-year trade school certification or degree

Submit the Partners for Clean Air Scholarship Application by the deadline date
