

BSME Games Hosting & Registration Process for 2024-25

Following on from 2023-24, the Games points system will be used again for the 2024-25 academic year. This system ensures that more BSME member schools host events and therefore hosting is a shared responsibility.

We will also require deposits for participation in the Games to be paid by **03 June 2024**. This allows host schools enough time to plan a successful event.

Games Host Schools & Registration Timeline

- 08 January 2024: BSME Students Coordinator sends Student Events Hosting request form for 2024-25 to all Heads of PE/BSME Members at 09:00 GST
- 25 January 2024: Student Events Hosting request form closes at 09:00 GST
- 29 January 26 February 2024: BSME Students Coordinator confirms Student Events Host Schools for 2024-25
- **04 March 2024:** BSME Students Coordinator sends Games Registration Form to all Heads of PE at 10:00 GST for Games participation
- 29 March 2024: Registration Form closes at 12:00 GST
- 15 April 2024: BSME Students Coordinator makes schools aware of which Games they have been allocated entries or confirmation if any Games are at capacity
- 17 April 26 April 2024: Schools confirm their participation in the Games
- 29 April 03 May 2024: Invoices are sent to each school for their non-refundable Games deposit fee for ALL Games that they have requested to participate in.
- 29 April 03 June 2024: Schools make their non-refundable deposit payments of \$3000 per school, per team entry. For example, if your school is entering an U15 and U13 team, there will be a fee of \$3000 per Games, so \$6000 will be due.
- **03 June 2024:** If the deposit is not received by 03 June 2024, schools will not be able to participate in the Games under any circumstances.

Points System

- All BSME Games will have a maximum of x12 schools entered, unless a host school is able to accommodate x16 schools
- The x12 schools that are able to enter each games are the x12 schools with the highest ranking points
- These x12 schools are required to pay their deposits by 03 June 2024. If the deposit has not been paid, the 13th highest ranking school will be given entry, then 14th, 15th, and so on
- The deposit required will cover all the Games that each school is entering for the following academic year
- All stand alone BSME events are based on a first-come first-paid first-served basis
- Points allocated as follows:

2024-25

- For this second year of the points coming into play, if a school has **no hosting points** they are able to enter **ONE** games only if that Games is not at capacity. Schools with hosting points take priority over schools with no hosting points
- Qatar schools will be allocated points based on the three years that they were able to host a BSME Event prior to the blockade
- Pre-allocation of points for two years ahead, i.e. 2024-25 & 2025-26, when the registration form opens
- New members are able to offer to host from 2024-25; they would be allocated their points when the registration form opens
- **U11 Games Tiers** Three host schools required, giving us a capacity of x36 schools. Games allocation will be based on the total number of students in Year 6; schools will then be split into Small, Medium & Large Games accordingly.
- BSME Saudi Members As we have received confirmation that any individual under the age of 18
 entering Saudi is still unable to obtain a visit visa unless they are accompanied by a parent it
 would not be feasible for Saudi schools to host in person events. Saudi members are exempt
 from the hosting point rule for the 2024-25 academic year and we will review this exemption on a
 year by year basis.
- **BSME Kuwait Members** Given the difficulties faced obtaining visas during the U19 Games and Music Festival, Kuwait members are exempt from the hosting point rule for the 2024-25 academic year and we will review this exemption on a year by year basis.

BSME Games Dates 2024-25

U19 Games - Friday 15th/ Saturday 16th/ Sunday 17th November 2024 - Two host schools may be required or one host school for x14 - x16 team tournament (x14 schools previously participated)

U15 Games - Thursday 16th/ Friday 17th/ Saturday 18th/ Sunday 19th January 2025 - Two host schools required (x22 schools previously participated)

U13 Games - Thursday 30th/ Friday 31st/ Saturday 1st/ Sunday 2nd February 2025 **OR** Thursday 6th/ Friday 7th/ Saturday 8th/ Sunday 9th February 2025 (dates TBC once calendars are finalised and 3 dates in total to be chosen) - Two host schools required (x28 schools previously participated)

U11 Games - Given that Ramadan is due to begin around the 28th Feb, we are preliminary looking at holding the U11 Games during the week Monday 17th/ Tuesday 18th/ Wednesday 19th or Monday 24th/ Tuesday 25th/ Wednesday 26th of February 2025 **OR** Friday 21st/ Saturday 22nd/ Sunday 23rd February (Dates TBC once calendars are finalised and 3 dates in total to be chosen)

BSME Individual Events & Sports Tournaments 2023-24

- Schools host individual events and sports tournaments for a two year period. Events can be allocated to a new host school after the two year hosting period is up (beginning from 2022-23)
- Should no new host school come forward, then the original host can remain the host school for the next two year period
- These events include:
 - U11 Netball Tournament
 - U13/ U15 Netball Tournament
 - U11 Football Tournament
 - o U13/ U15 Football Tournament
 - Golf Open
 - Swimming Championship
 - Volleyball Championship
 - o Dance Invitational
