Y10 Work Experience - Parent Information Evening, 15 January 6pm



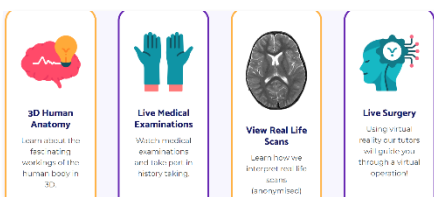

Y9 – Y13 DoctorsLive - Virtual Anatomy Club (February 2024 to April 2024) - Live Every Tuesday 6pm-8pm



Are you thinking of a career in Science and Healthcare, e.g. medicine, nursing, dentistry or other Allied Health Professions? If you are, take a look at Anatomy Club. This is a 3-month after-school programme covering all 12 organ systems. The sessions run for 2 hours weekly, every Tuesday evening, led by two practising doctors. You will cover the body systems in a fun and interactive manner by dissecting a virtual anatomy model. You will also cover diseases affecting the organ system and try to solve anonymised real-life

patient cases. You will be able to interact with practising surgeons and doctors. Each live session is recorded and can be accessed anytime.
