**Lunch Fee:**

The lunch fee is required in grades 1-4 and all-day Montessori 3-to-6-year-old programs based on the program selected. Lunch for Middle and Upper School students is available for purchase in the main dining hall. Parents are required to set up a PayPAMS account online to pre-pay their child's lunch purchases.

**Class Trips:**

Class trips are related to the curriculum and are required for Middle School students. Grades 5 and 7 participate in day trips. Grade 6 participates in an overnight camp experience and grade 8 students travel to Washington, D.C.

**Optional Fees and Programs not included above:**

Piano and violin lessons are available for students in grades K-12 for \$1,080 per semester/\$2,160 per year and are not refundable. World Language class is available for AM half-day Montessori students enrolled in the 3-6-year-old program at a cost of \$600 per semester.

**Bus Transportation:**

Summit provides transportation for students from West Chester/Lakota/Mason areas at an annual roundtrip fee per family of \$1,700 or \$860 one-way AM or PM. Bus service from select school districts is provided by that district at no cost to Summit families.

**Advanced Placement Test Fees:**

Upper School students who take AP courses are required to take the AP test and pay the associated fee.

## Tuition Payment Options

The Summit understands that you have to make a variety of financial decisions when deciding how to pay for your child's education. Please contact the Business Office at [cox\\_b@summitcds.org](mailto:cox_b@summitcds.org) or 513-871-4700, ext. 206, regarding any questions you have about the following Summit payment options. **Payment plans are by family, not student. One account per family.** Parents with shared tuition responsibility, please contact the Business Office at 513-871-4700, ext. 206. **The \$1,000 tuition deposit should be submitted online with the contract.**

**Plan A – One payment by July 1, 2024.** Pay the tuition and fees, less the \$1,000 tuition deposit, less \$200 discount (if applicable) by July 1, 2024. A \$25 Blackbaud account fee per family will be assessed on the July 1, 2024 payment. Plan A families may choose to receive an invoice, pay by electronic funds transfer (EFT) or credit card. There is a 3.12% convenience fee assessed by Blackbaud for all credit card payments.

*Plan A discount of \$200 will only be applied to student accounts of full-time students who receive no tuition assistance to include merit and/or endowed scholarships. Montessori students must be enrolled in five full-day programs without tuition assistance to include endowed scholarships to be eligible for the \$200 discount.*

**Plan B – Two payments July 15, 2024 and January 15, 2025.** Pay the tuition and fees less the \$1,000 tuition deposit in two installments – 50% installment due July 15, 2024, 50% due January 15, 2025. A \$50 Blackbaud account fee per family will be assessed on the July 15, 2024 payment. Plan B families may choose to receive an invoice, pay by electronic funds transfer (EFT) or credit card. There is a 3.12% convenience fee assessed by Blackbaud for all credit card payments.

**Plan C – 10 Monthly payments June 15, 2024-March 15, 2025.** Pay the tuition and fees less the \$1,000 tuition deposit over ten months. A \$50 Blackbaud account fee per family will be assessed on the June 15, 2024 payment. **Plan C families are required to pay by recurring electronic funds transfer (EFT) or credit card.** There is a 3.12% convenience fee assessed by Blackbaud for all credit card payments.

**Tuition Assistance/Aspire Family Plan/EdChoice Scholarship:** The Summit has traditional need-based tuition assistance for qualifying students age three to grade 12. The Aspire Family Plan provides assistance opportunities for families with multiple children in Kindergarten through grade 8. The EdChoice Scholarship Program is available to Ohio students in Kindergarten to grade 12 and is required for any family receiving tuition assistance.
