Title: Board of Directors' Organizational Meeting and Election of Officers in School Election

Years

The Board of Directors shall, in school election years, meet and organize at the first regular

meeting after the canvass (official election results) for a regular school election. Notice of the

place and hour of such meeting shall be given by the secretary to each member and each

member-elect of the Board.

At the organizational meeting, the Secretary or designee will administer the oath of office to the

newly-elected Board members. The Secretary will preside while the new Board elects the

President and Vice President of the Board for the term of one year. The secretary, treasurer or

designee will administer the oath of office to the new officers. The newly-elected President will

preside over the remainder of the meeting. The Board shall set the dates and times of regular

meetings for the year.
