

Title: Board of Directors' Legislative Activities

The Board of Directors is encouraged to be actively involved in the state and federal legislative process as it pertains to District operation and issues. Involvement may take the form of appointment of Board members as legislative liaisons, and periodic reports and discussions as appropriate.

It shall be the responsibility of the Superintendent to assist the Board in keeping current on proposed laws and in contacting the elected officials who represent the District. Actual and necessary expenses incurred by individual Board members in the performance of official duties associated with legislative activities shall be reimbursed upon review by the President and approval of warrants by the Board.
