

## Title: Paraeducators

The Council Bluffs Community School District may employ paraeducators to assist licensed instructional personnel in non-teaching duties. Such duties may be performed in the presence or absence of licensed instructional staff but shall be under the direction, supervision and control of the licensed instructional staff. Paraeducators may supervise, monitor or provide services to students in a supportive role under conditions determined by the professional staff responsible for the students. The paraeducator may not assume the role, duties or functions of a substitute for or replacement of a teacher or other licensed instructional staff member as outlined in Iowa Code, unless he or she holds a paraeducator certificate and has successfully completed the state-approved Substitute Authorization program. Paraeducators meeting these requirements will be restricted to substituting in the special education classroom in which they are assigned. Paraeducators may not substitute for more than five consecutive days, and no more than ten days in a thirty-day period in one assignment.
