Title: Use of Electronic Surveillance and Security Equipment - Students

The Board of Directors authorizes the use of surveillance and security devices and measures, such as, but not limited to, video cameras, web cameras, audio surveillance devices, motion environmental detectors and alarms on District property and on contracted buses. These devices and equipment contribute to the health, welfare and safety of all staff, students and visitors while on District property and are additional safeguards for District facilities, property and equipment.

Such equipment may be used in locations as deemed appropriate by the Superintendent.

Students in violation of Board policies, administrative regulations, building rules and/or local, state or federal law may be subject to appropriate disciplinary action and may be referred to law enforcement agencies as appropriate.

The District shall annually notify students and parents that electronic surveillance may occur on District property. This notice shall be included with other required notices in the District-Wide Student & Family Handbook. Surveillance records may become a part of a student's educational record and such records may be shared with law enforcement in accordance with applicable law. Video, photographs, and sound collected by surveillance devices can be used in determining appropriate disciplinary action. The District shall comply with all applicable local, state and federal laws governing the use and maintenance of electronic surveillance devices and security systems and for the retention of electronic data.
