

Title: Student Immunization

Every parent or legal guardian enrolling a student or students in a District preschool, elementary, secondary school or any licensed child care program operating in District facilities shall be required to provide evidence of the student having received State required immunizations. Applicants for enrollment who have begun but not completed the required immunizations may be granted provisional enrollment. To be granted provisional enrollment, applicants shall have received at least one dose of each of the required vaccines or be a transfer student from another school system.

Exclusions to these rules will be permitted on an individual basis for medical and religious reasons only upon submitting a valid Iowa department of public health certificate of immunization exemption.

The Board retains the authority to deny enrollment or continued enrollment to any student without documentation of compliance with the minimum immunization requirements as specified by the Iowa Code and the State Department of Health and to require at any time a certification of good health for any student.
