## **IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS**

Applicants enrolled or attempting to enroll shall have received the following vaccines in accordance with the doses and age requirements listed below. If, at any time, the age of the child is between the listed ages, the child must have received the number of doses in the "Total Doses Required" column. Hib vaccine is not required for persons 60 months of age or older 4 doses if the applicant received 3 doses before 12 months of age; or 24 months of 3 doses if the applicant received 2 doses before 24 months of age; or age and older Pneumococcal 2 doses if the applicant received 1 dose before 24 months of age; or 1 dose if the applicant did not receive any doses before 24 months of age. Pneumococcal vaccine is not required for persons 60 months of age or older. 1 dose of measles/rubella-containing vaccine received on or after 12 months of age; or the applicant demonstrates a Measles/Rubella<sup>1</sup> positive antibody test for measles and rubella from a U.S. laboratory. 1 dose received on or after 12 months of age, unless the applicant has had a reliable history of natural disease. Varicella 3 doses, with at least 1 dose of diphtheria/tetanus/pertussis-containing vaccine received on or after 4 years of age if the applicant was born on or before September 15, 2000<sup>2</sup>; or Elementary or Secondary School 4 doses, with at least 1 dose of diphtheria/tetanus/pertussis-containing vaccine received on or after 4 years of age if the Diphtheria/Tetanus/ applicant was born after September 15, 2000, but on or before September 15, 2003<sup>2</sup>; or Pertussis 4, 5 5 doses with at least 1 dose of diphtheria/tetanus/pertussis-containing vaccine received on or after 4 years of age if the applicant was born after September 15, 2003<sup>2, 3</sup>; and 1 time dose of tetanus/diphtheria/acellular pertussis-containing vaccine (Tdap) for the applicant in grades 7 and above, if born after September 15, 2000; regardless of the interval since the last tetanus/diphtheria-containing vaccine. 3 doses, with at least 1 dose received on or after 4 years of age if the applicant was born on or before September 15. 20037: or Polic (K-12) 4 doses, with at least 1 dose received on or after 4 years of age if the applicant was born after September 15, 2003.6 4 years of age Polio vaccine is not required for persons 18 years of age or older. and older 2 doses of measles/rubella-containing vaccine; the first dose shall have been received on or after 12 months of age; the Measles/Rubella<sup>1</sup> second dose shall have been received no less than 28 days after the first dose; or the applicant demonstrates a positive antibody test for measles and rubella from a U.S. laboratory. Hepatitis B 3 doses 1 dose received on or after 12 months of age if the applicant was born on or after September 15, 1997, but born on or before September 15, 2003, unless the applicant has had a reliable history of natural disease; or Varicella 2 doses received on or after 12 months of age if the applicant was born after September 15, 2003, unless the applicant has a reliable history of natural disease.<sup>8</sup> 1 dose of meningococcal vaccine received on or after 10 years of age for the applicant in grades 7 and above, if born after September 15, 2004; and Meningococcal (A. C. W. Y) 2 doses of meningococcal vaccines for the applicant in grade 12, if born after September 15, 1999; or 1 dose if received when the applicant is 16 years of age or older.

Mumps vaccine may be included in measles/hubella-containing vaccine.
DTaP is not indicated for persons 7 years of age or older, therefore, a tetanus and diphtheria-containing vaccine should be used.
The 5% does of DTaP is not necessary if the 4<sup>m</sup> does was administered on or after 4 years of age.
Applicants 7 through 18 years of age who received their 1<sup>d</sup> does of diphtheria/tetanus/pertursis-containing vaccine before 12 months of age should receive a total of 4 doses, with one of those doses administered on or after 4 years of age.

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If an applicant received an all-inactivated poliovinus (IPV) or all-oral poliovirus (OPV) series, a 4<sup>th</sup> dose is not necessary if the 3<sup>rd</sup> dose was administered on or after 4 years of age. 7 If both OPV and IPV were administered as part of the series, a total of 4 doses are required.

\* Administer 2 does of varicella vaccine, al least 3 months apart, to applicants less than 13 years of age. Do not repeat the 2<sup>rd</sup> does if administered 28 days or greater from the 1<sup>#</sup> dose. Administer 2 does of varicella vaccine to applicants 13 years of age or older at least 4 weeks apart. The minimum interval between the 1# and 2m dose of varicella for an applicant 13 years of age or older is 28 days. January 2017

- 3. The corresponding cell to the right of the number of previous doses in the "recommended regimen" column provides the recommended number of doses for the child.
