Title: Child Abuse and Dependent Adult Abuse Reporting and Investigation

The administration shall develop abuse reporting, identification and training procedures

that comply with legal requirements. All school employees or other mandatory reporters as

defined by law, who in the scope of professional practice or in their employment responsibilities,

examines, attends, counsels or treats a child and reasonably believes such child has suffered

abuse, are required to orally report such suspected cases of child abuse to the Department of

Human Services within 24 hours of becoming aware of the abusive incident. A written report

shall be filed within 48 hours of the oral report. Employees who are not mandatory reporters are

encouraged to report to the Department of Human Services or a supervisor.

All building administrators and other authorized personnel shall cooperate with abuse

investigators by providing confidential access to the student named in the report and to other

students alleged to have relevant information for the purpose of interviews. The investigators

shall determine who shall be present at the interviews. The immunity granted by Iowa Code

section 232.73 applies to the good faith actions or omissions of such administrators and other

authorized personnel and the District.
