Title: Musical Instrument Display Night

As a convenience and service to students and their parents, the District will conduct annual musical instrument display nights. The purpose of these evening activities is to provide a forum for qualified vendors to present, display and sell/rent musical instruments and accessories to interested students and their parents. Participation in these evening activities is voluntary on the part of all students and parents.

The schedule of events and specific activities shall be the responsibility of the administration.

Nothing in this policy may be considered to imply that any student is required to rent, lease or purchase a musical instrument from any company qualified as a vendor under these rules, nor is there any restriction that students who purchase instruments from vendors other than those qualified to participate in display night under this policy shall be in any way limited in or discouraged from band participation as a result of their choice to obtain their instrument from some other instrumental music source. The presence of a vendor at the event shall in no way serve as an endorsement by the District of that vendor or its products or services.

The District will solicit qualified vendor participation in the display nights. Specifications will be presented to potentially qualified vendors.

All qualified vendors will be allowed to participate in the display nights' activities. Qualification of each vendor will be determined by the District at its sole discretion, based on the vendor's willingness and ability to provide the required instruments of acceptable quality and quantity, as well as follow-up maintenance services.
