Title: Physical Education Exception

Students in grades Kindergarten-12 shall be required to participate in regularly scheduled physical education classes unless excused by the principal of their school.

The principal shall excuse a student from physical education when any one of the following conditions apply:

- 1. A written statement by a physician states the student should not participate because of illness or injury.
- 2. The activity in question would be detrimental to the student's health or is inappropriate as determined by the student's individualized education plan.
- 3. A written statement by a parent or guardian states religious beliefs are in conflict with the activity.
- 4. The student is enrolled in a cooperative, work-study or other educational program authorized by the Council Bluffs Community School District which requires the student's absence from the building.
- 5. The student is enrolled in an academic course not available at any other time.
- 6. The student has been approved for early graduation.
- 7. The student is enrolled in an activity that is sponsored by the school which requires at least as much physical activity per week as one-eighth unit of physical education.
