To achieve high school status, each Council Bluffs Community School District student must meet the performance expectations in the following classes: mathematics, literacy, social studies, science, physical education, exploratory and elective courses, based upon the established curriculum.

When an individual student is not meeting expectations, parents/legal guardians and the appropriate instructional staff will be involved in the decision to promote or retain. Each decision will be accompanied by an individual plan which will include a description of all interventions or accommodations designed to meet the needs of the student. However, the principal of each middle school is responsible for decisions to promote or retain.
