Title: High School Graduation Requirements/Foreign Exchange Students – Regulation

1. The sending institution of the exchange student must grant written permission for a diploma to be awarded.
2. If an exchange student has not received a high school diploma, that student must meet our graduation requirements. The principal of the receiving institution is responsible for the approval of the courses.
3. If a student has already received a high school diploma from their sending institution, another diploma will not be awarded.
4. A student who has received a diploma may receive a certificate of attendance and that student may participate in commencement ceremonies.
