

Title: Student Progress Reports to Parents

The Board of Directors supports the following objectives of student progress reporting:

1. To inform parents of the progress made by their children.
2. To give parents a better understanding of the school programs.
3. To record for students their growth and achievement.
4. To help students evaluate their own growth and achievement.
5. To help students, parents and the school work together.

Parents will be contacted at least twice per year regarding student progress. Contacts may include scheduled conferences, email correspondence, student-led conferences or any other method that helps meet the objectives listed in this policy.

Parents of children in grade kindergarten through grade 3 will be informed of their individual child's performance on screening assessments at least twice per year.

Elementary and middle school progress reports will communicate progress toward achieving the student learning expectations. This includes letter grades beginning in middle school. High school progress reports to parents will include letter grades and information about graduation credits.
