Title: Providing Textbooks to Nonpublic Schools

Cross References:

The District shall comply with those sections of Chapter 301, Iowa Code, that relate to provision of textbook service to nonpublic schools located within the District boundaries.

Any difference between the amount of money spent on textbooks for nonpublic students and the amount of money reimbursed by the State Department of Education shall be billed to and paid for by the using nonpublic school.

The administration is authorized to contract with school districts that have students attending nonpublic schools located in the District to have the District provide the textbook services. The correspondent school district shall pay the District for the entire amount of the service and shall resolve any differences in amounts as described above.
