Title: Virtual/Online Learning

The District may provide a virtual education through virtual learning as a means of instruction for students. A virtual education is defined as instruction at various grade levels through internet, web-based methods or other computer-assisted learning. Virtual learning increases accessibility and flexibility in the delivery of instruction, and does not require the student to be physically present in the same location as the instructor or other students.

In addition to regular classroom-based instruction, students in the District may even credit through virtual learning provided by virtual instructors. All virtual learning courses will be consistent with District instructional goals and curriculum. Virtual instruction may be the sole medium for learning when criteria has been met and maintained in accordance with virtual learning guidelines. Students must enroll in virtual learning as part of the regular registration process.

Virtual learning will be made available within District budgeting parameter.s Virtual learning may be used to provide homebound instruction.
