

Title: Tobacco-Free/Nicotine-Free Environment

The Board of Directors recognizes its responsibility to provide a healthy, safe and productive environment in which to work and learn. In meeting this responsibility, the Board directs that a tobacco-free environment be established and maintained. There will be no smoking or use of tobacco, nicotine products, vaporizers, e-cigarettes or the electronic nicotine delivery systems in any District building or vehicle, or on District grounds at any time. No smoking shall be permitted in any vehicle located on District grounds. These prohibitions apply to all persons, including students, employees and visitors, and apply at all times, including school-sponsored and non-school-sponsored activities. Visitors failing to abide by this policy shall be required to immediately extinguish or otherwise cease the use of tobacco products or leave the School District premises. Students and employees violating this policy may be subject to disciplinary action. It is the responsibility of the administration to enforce this policy.
