Title: Relations with Parent Organizations - Regulation

It shall be the responsibility of a designated building administrator to be the liaison with all parent organizations. A parent or group of parents interested in forming a new parent organization shall confer with the building administrator to ensure the organization's purpose and

activities directly and positively support the overall educational experience for students.

Parent organizations conducting fundraising or events on behalf of the school or students shall annually supply to the Chief Financial Officer the organization's purpose, legal status and the type of fund raising and other activities or events sponsored. Receipt of this information will

entitle the parent organization coverage under the District's liability insurance.

Prior to any purchase of or fundraising for the purchase of goods or services for the District, the parent organization shall receive approval from the building administrator to ensure the group in purchasing goods or services in compliance with District contractual agreements

and to meet the District's identified needs.

Parent organizations shall receive approval from the building administrator on the scheduling and type of event or fundraising activity planned, and provide annually a fundraising activities report, detailing the revenue, expenses, and what was purchased with the funds raised.
