MINUTES OF ETHICS COMMISSION
SPECIAL MEETING

JANUARY 4, 2024

A special meeting was held at 7:00 P.M.

The meeting, prompted by a complaint filed by a resident of Suffield on December 27, 2023, was called to order by Chairman Jay Presser at 7:00 P.M. The purpose of the meeting was to conduct an inquiry, pursuant to its rules, to decide whether the Complaint established probable cause to believe a violation of the Code of Ethics had occurred, so as to warrant an investigation.

The meeting began with the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance followed by a roll call.

Members present: Scott Wheeler, George Dalrymple, Jay Presser, and Carol Martin.

Members Absent: Dara Goings

Alternates Present: Susan Keane, who was authorized to vote on all business.

Others Present: No other members of the public were present.

The complaint was discussed in executive session by the ethics committee members and the alternate member present, who was authorized to discuss and vote on the complaint. All present participated in the discussion.

The members returned to open session at 7:22 P.M. At that time the Chairman called for a vote on whether there was probable cause believe a violation of the Code of Ethics had occurred. The Commission members unanimously voted that there was no probable cause, and the complaint was dismissed.

The meeting was adjourned by Chairman at 7:25 P.M.
