

  - BTW overview: Once permit is obtained, you are eligible to create an account. You can log on to schedule a lesson by selecting the site, date, time, and instructor. It is recommended to wait one month before first lesson. Space lessons out every 3-4 weeks. The last lesson is the test, and it can be taken on or after the eligibility date (6 months after obtaining permit). Locations are both at PHS and at CLIU #21. No need to try to schedule at the DMV


# Club Proposal


