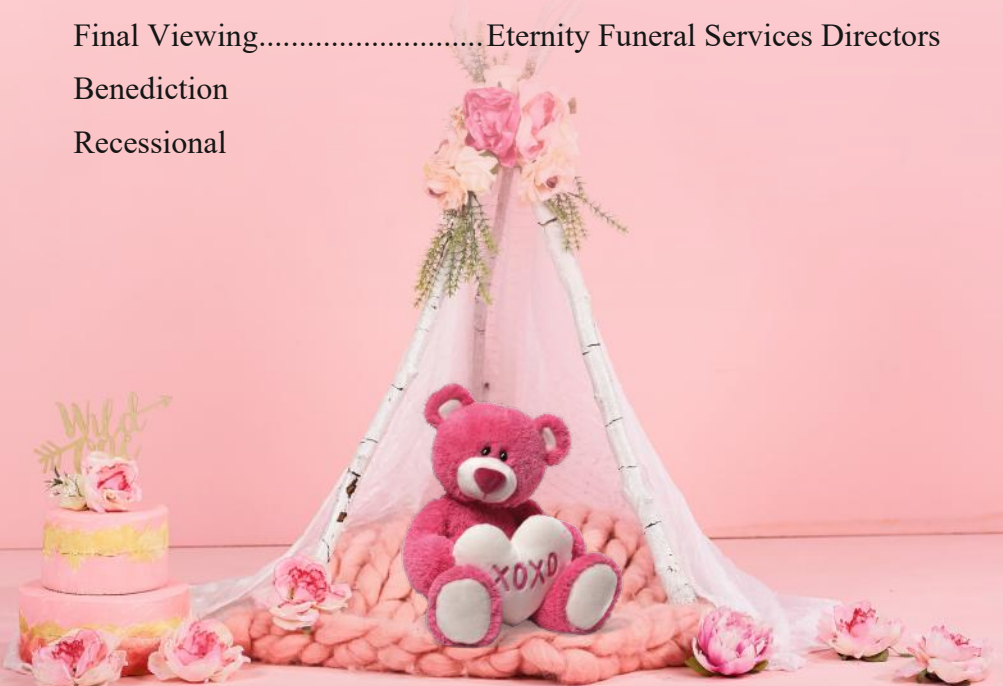

# Obituary

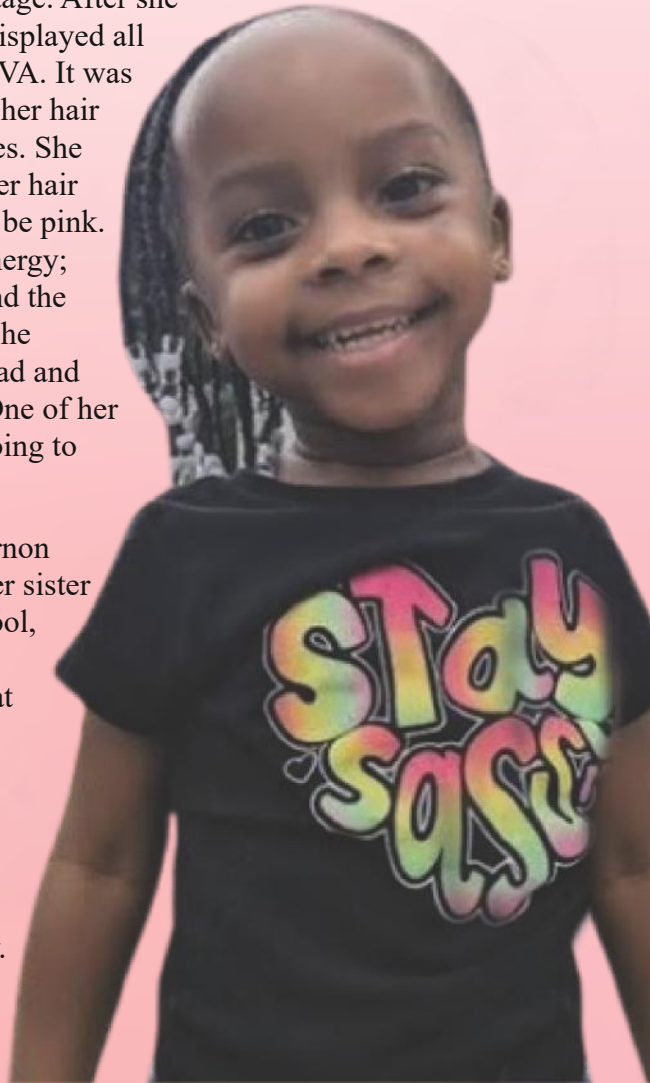

Praising my Savior all the day long.

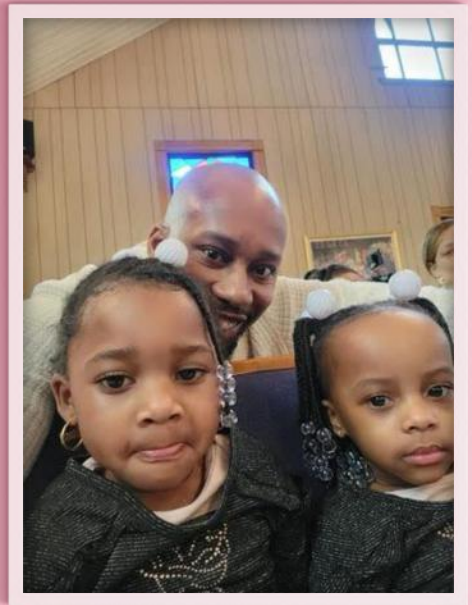
Perfect submission, perfect delight,
