## PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Middle School students are exposed to a wide variety of enrichment and exploratory courses. 5th and 6th grade students rotate through these offerings on a quarterly system. 7th and 8th grade students enroll in one elective each semester. Enrichment and elective options vary by grade and semester. Offerings include Spanish (5th grade), 2D Visual Art, Pottery, Photography, General Music/Drama, Music Ensemble, Engineering Design, Content Creators, Communication and Public Speaking, and Life Skills.

Students in grades 5th through 8th enjoy physical education two to three days a week depending on the grade level. Curriculum varies by grade but highlights include essential components of physical education, team sport instruction, stimulating games, teambuilding activities, fitness instruction, and weight training.
