About the Program

Read for RMHC-CR is a reading based community service program that raises funds to support RMHC® of the Capital Region through partnerships with local elementary and middle schools. In addition to helping the children and families served by RMHC-CR, the program:

- Promotes the value of community service
- Encourages students to read
- Gives students first hand experience with the difference they can make in the lives of others.

Program Details

JANUARY

- A special assembly or video presentation is offered to get students excited to read for a good cause.
- Students seek out family and friends to sponsor their reading for the month with pledges of either a flat amount for all reading accomplished during the month, or a specific amount of money pledged per minute read during the month.

- On **January 8th**, students start reading. Students will **read from January 8th through January 31st**. Students may keep a record of their minutes spent reading on their reading calendar. Minutes can be entered in the calendar electronically and saved on the computer or students may print the calendar to write in minutes. Minutes when others read to students count too, so be sure to count them! Readers are welcome to listen to stories from our Read for RMHC Video Story Library too! After the selected reading month has ended:

- Donations are to be **either entered online or turned in to school with completed sponsor forms by** the deadline set by the school - **February 2nd**.
- All student participants receive a personalized participation certificate.
- Students who read and raise donations will receive Read for RMHC-CR prizes and an invitation to tour RMHC.
- All participating schools receive a personalized thank you letter.

2023-2024 Program Prizes!

The following prizes are available for 2023-2024 Read for RMHC-CR participating students and schools:

- RMHC 2024 Birthday Bash** - child admission free with paid adult admission for each student who reads and earns donations for RMHC-CR.
- Read for RMHC-CR Slap Bracelet** - awarded to every student who reads and earns \$10 or more in donations for RMHC-CR.

1. Once you have reached the webpage, in the upper right corner, click on the magnifying glass and search for **the name of your school** and click your school's name under **Teams**.
2. Click the **Join Team** button on the left side of the page.
3. In Start Fundraising box, click **Login** if you have done online fundraising with Read for RMHC in the past. If you do not remember your password, click **Forgot Password** in the Login box to reset your password. Click **Create an account** to create a new account if you don't already have one. Enter your email address and create a password. Click **Next**.
4. Under "Complete your profile," enter the first and last name of the **student** who will be participating. Click **Sign up**.
5. Enter information to "Create your page," to customize your fundraising webpage. Click **Finish**.
6. Now you are ready to spread the word that you are reading and raising funds for Ronald McDonald House Charities® of the Capital Region!
