IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR KINDERGARTEN

THE FOLLOWING VACCINES ARE REQUIRED BY LAW BEFORE STUDENTS CAN BEGIN KINDERGARTEN, SO PLEASE MAKE AN APPOINTMENT FOR YOUR CHILD AS SOON AS POSSIBLE AS TO NOT DELAY THEIR START

DATE:

- 1. Diphtheria, Tetanus, & Pertussis(DTaP): 4 doses**
(one dose must be given on or after 4th birthday)
- 2. Polio (IPV or OPV): 3 doses**
(one dose must be given on or after 4th birthday)
- 3. Measles, Mumps, & Rubella (MMR): 2 doses**
(first dose must be given on or after 1st birthday, and spacing between doses is 4 weeks)
- 4. Varicella “Chickenpox”: 2 doses**
(first dose must be given on or after 1st birthday, spacing between doses is 12 weeks for children under 13 years, and 4 weeks for those older than 13 years)

Documentation of a valid medical or religious exemption or conditional enrollment may be submitted in lieu of receiving all required vaccines. See Montana DPHHS website or LPS Nursing website for more information.

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Has serious allergies to food or insects

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Has any serious illnesses, injuries, or accidents
