Replacement Levy

Levy dollars make up the difference between what the state provides for K-12 basic education and what it actually costs to provide options that prepare students for today's world.

✓ **NOT a new tax**

✓ Continues essential student programs and services

- Football, Basketball, Baseball, Track
- Clubs
- Music Supplies
- Shop Supplies
- Field Trips
- Technology
- Security
- Building Repairs

✓ Levy amount of \$209,000 will continue for 4 years

How much?

The replacement levy amount will be \$209,000, or approximately \$1.48 per \$1000 of assessed property value. (Based on estimated 2024 TAV).

For 2023, the levy rate was \$1.29 per \$1,000. The replacement levy would be an increase of about \$0.19 per \$1,000.

A property with \$200,000 assessed value would pay \$38 more per year with the levy replacement.

If approved, this levy will replace the one expiring at the end of 2024. Without this new levy, programs will be cut or eliminated.
