In compliance with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), LDISD performed inspections of the District's buildings and campus for asbestos-containing material (ACM) in 1988. The inspection findings and asbestos management plans have been on file in the school administrative office since that time.

The EPA requires that schools perform reinspections of the ACM identified at the school buildings. In November of 2017, an AHERA-accredited and Texas Department of State Health Services (TDSHS)-Licensed Asbestos Inspector performed the most current reinspection LDISD. A TDSHS-licensed Management Planner reviewed the results of the reinspection and recommended actions we should take to safely manage the ACM identified in our District.

The identified ACM has been assessed to be in good condition at this time and is included in our Operations & Maintenance (O&M) Program. We will continue to monitor this material for any changes in condition.

The results of the reinspection are on file in the Management Plan in the administrative office and in the Principal's office at each school campus. Anyone is welcome to view these documents anytime during normal school hours.
