These guidelines are published by the Web Accessibility Initiative 7 (WAI) of the World Wide Web Consortium (W3C), the main international standards organization 8 9 for the Internet. 10 Members of the public may present a complaint regarding a violation of Title II of the Americans 11 with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990 or Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, related to 12 the accessibility of any official Division web presence, which is developed by, maintained by, or 13 offered through the school division or third-party vendors.
