



Early College with Rochester University



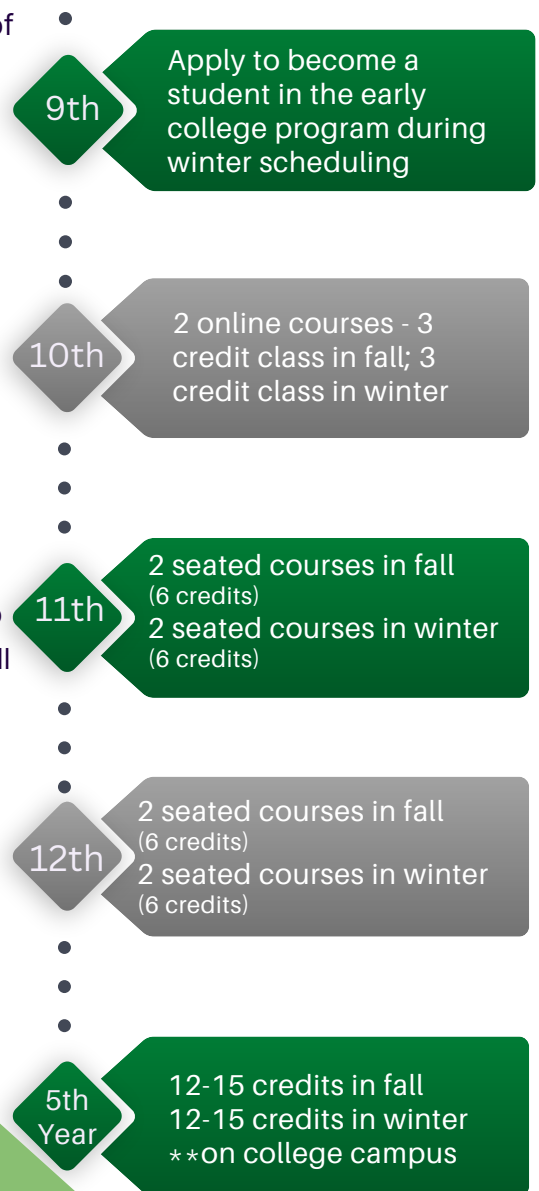
We are excited to partner with Rochester University to provide an Early College program housed at LOHS!

Lake Orion High School has partnered with Rochester University to offer a no-cost early college program for our students. This program consists of a 5 year course of study - the traditional 4 years of high school, plus one year of full time college studies on a college campus.

- During Sophomore year, students will be enrolled in 2 college courses, one in the fall semester and one in the winter semester. Content of both classes will be delivered in an online format by Rochester University instructors, while students remain at Lake Orion High School and are supervised and mentored by a Lake Orion staff member.
- Junior and Senior years, early college students will participate in 2 college courses each semester. All classes during these 2 years are instructed by Rochester University instructors, with the classes being held at Lake Orion High School*.
- During the 5th Year, early college students will take college courses on campus and/or online through Rochester University, one which needs to be a math related class. In addition to their college courses, students will also complete a capstone service project during this year, as well as maintain regular communication with their Lake Orion staff mentor.

Early college students will "walk" with their graduating class, but receipt of their actual diploma will be held off until completion of all early college requirements that following school year.

Students apply to the early college program during the scheduling process in February of their 9th grade year.



*minimum of 15 students in each cohort must be met for junior and senior year classes to be held at Lake Orion High School.
