Highlights:

Teaching & Learning

Summer School planning is underway, and we will soon see the posting of key leadership positions as we plan for effective and accessible summer school learning for identified students. The programs are an important part of a 12-month system of intervention to continue to close learning gaps and prepare students for the next grade level.

Elementary teachers continue to receive ongoing and embedded support in the updating of **effective literacy practices** with monthly professional learning, peer supports and connection to experts daily. The implementation of phonics and phonemic awareness curriculum and tools has been widely successful and well-received by our talented team of teachers. Our next steps include the full review of core reading materials as well as screening tools to bring the redesign into full alignment with what we know to be best practice.

Kindergarten Round-Up Events

As we get ready for the new year, it's not too early to start thinking about some of our youngest students who will start their AAPS experience as kindergarten and young fives students in the fall of 2024. Kindergarten Round-Up events are scheduled throughout the month of February and March at our elementary schools and K-8 buildings. We are excited to share with families the fun that awaits your children, meet our school staff, learn about the programs, the enrollment process and get answers to your questions.
