Next week we will have "benchmark testing" or "assessment sweeps". This is Acadience testing that is conducted by our Reading Interventionists (Miss Lewis and Mrs. Farrance) and our RTI Case Managers (Mrs. Rinehart, Mrs. Schwertner and Mrs. Pruchnicki)

All students take these relatively short assessments.

The data that is gathered from this testing helps the staff in deciding services, interventions and rigor.
