Daniela and Chris explained that, due to a connection to a parent in the community, their English 12: Race Lit. and English 12 Honors classes have the opportunity to meet with the author, Georgia Hunter. Hunter is available to visit the classrooms in January. She will share her connection to the book, as well as the long process of writing it. Hulu will premier a miniseries based on the book in March. This will enable students to watch the book come to life on the screen. The actors in the miniseries are of Jewish descent, which connects to Race Lit. conversations around identity and representation.

Twombly and Melgar offered that the book portrays a different version of the holocaust from those they typically cover, such as in *Night* or *Maus*. It is not centered in a concentration camp. But it is painful and challenging and shows how World War 2 was truly a World War – with survivors spread out everywhere.

Vote: Kristy Siekhaus motioned to approve *We Were the Lucky Ones* – Nonfiction – as pilot instructional material for English 12: Race, Identity, and Representation in Comparative Literature, and English 12 Honors for the 2023-24 school year. Chris-Cocklin-Ray seconded the motion. There were nine approvals, one opposition, and no abstentions. The motion passed.
