

**Tigard-Tualatin School District
Results of October 2015 Water Quality Testing**

Pursuant to its policy, the Tigard-Tualatin School District conducted voluntary random testing for possible lead levels in drinking water at district schools.

The specific results are listed below and shown in parts per billion ("ppb"). The results were obtained from protocols specified by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA").

Based on this sample event, there are no results that exceed EPA's recommended level of 20 ppb. For this set of data, "ND" means no detection, which represents results that are less than 2 ppb.
